The Sportsplex is located in scenic Feasterville, Bucks County Pennsylvania on 20 acres of manicured ground, and is mere minutes from the PA Turnpike, I-95, and US Route 1.

The facility boasts over 100,000 square feet of indoor space, which includes three identical competition-sized roller hockey rinks surfaced with Sport Court flooring. Home to many indoor soccer and roller hockey events, the Sportsplex is also proud to host events for many other sports, including martial arts, field hockey, gymnastics, tennis, and cheerleading.

The Sportsplex ground encompasses the Mill Creek Picnic Grounds which includes an Olympic sized pool, toddler pool, sand volleyball court, tether ball, horse shoe pits, miniature golf, eight clay-surface tennis courts, softball field, and outdoor soccer fields.

Team Registration Fee and Application Deadline: June 15, 2009

A) **Special International Division Discounted Entry Fee.** It is \$395.00 U.S. dollars per team; add \$200.00 for the AAU club level if playing in both divisions.

NOTE: Regular price is \$995.00 for the international division and \$995.00 for the club division which equals \$1990.0 total for only \$595.00. This is a \$1395.00 discount per team.

Format: Teams are guaranteed 5 games in each international division and you could play up to 8 games. Teams are guaranteed five games in the club divisions, but most will play 6-8. International teams could play 10-16 games except the USA, who will compete in the International Division only. Team USA members will go to their club teams after the International Divisions are completed.

Awards: Teams will be presented gold, silver, bronze, and copper medals to all members of each team placing in the top four in each age classification. Team awards are given to the top teams in each division and age group.
