Please find below the main topics addressed during the World Skate Executive Board meeting held on 25 June 2021.

Approval of the minutes of the previous Executive Board meeting

The Minutes of the previous EB meeting are unanimously approved.

Approval of the 2020 Financial Report

The 2020 Financial Report is unanimously approved.

World Skate Facilities

World Skate is setting-up a Facilities Department with the aim to supervise track and skatepark constructions in order to reach an international and Olympic standard all over the world.

World Skate Elective Congress

The date set to held World Skate Elective Congress is 27th of November 2021. Within the end of July a final decision will be made about the European city hosting the Congress, as well as about the participation modality - in person or remote.

World Skate World Championships 2021

As athletes' health and safety represent World Skate's main priority, the Executive Board decided to try and keep its commitment with the Paraguayan and Colombian federations. World Skate is continuously monitoring the situation about the upcoming World Championships and the COVID-19 protocols to be observed during the events. Artistic World Championships in Paraguay are confirmed. Speed skating and Inline hockey World Championships in Colombia are under examination. Confirmation will come in the next few days. Confirmed also the Scooter World Championships to be held in September in Barcelona, Spain.

Inline Alpine Rulebooks, Inline Freestyle World Ranking

The Executive Board received and ratified the above-mentioned Rulebook and Ranking.

World Skate Paralympic Commission

World Skate is launching the World Skate Paralympic Commission. Josh Friedberg (USA) has been appointed as Chairman of the World Skate Paralympic Commission.
