



DEFINITION OF INTERNATIONAL ATHLETE

JANUARY 1, 2021

Version 1

The following groups of World Skate athletes are classified as International Athletes for doping control purposes

- (a) *Athletes* included in World Skate's *Registered Testing Pool*;
- (b) *Athletes* included in World Skate's *Testing Pool2*;
- (c) *Athletes* who compete in any World Skate World Championship in any discipline in the Senior or Open category;
- (d) *Athletes* who compete in the Senior or Open level at *World Cup Events*;
- (e) *Athletes* who compete in the Senior or Open level at the *World Skate Games*;
- (f) *Athletes* who compete in the Open, Park and/or Street category at the *World Skate Skateboarding World Championships*; and
- (g) *Athletes* who compete in a *Pro Tour Event* including *World Skate SLS Pro Tour* and *Dew Tour Events*; and
- (h) *Athletes* who compete in any *5-star Event* including *Skate Total Urbe (STU) Open Events*, *International Skateboarding Open Events*, *ARK League Events*, or *World Skate Open Skateboarding Events*.

Athletes shall not be considered *International-Level Athletes* if they have not competed in any of the above *Events* or categories in the current or preceding competition year.

Specific Rules in the World Skate antidoping Rules which apply to International-Level Athletes shall apply to these athletes (e.g., Testing, TUEs, whereabouts, and Results Management) shall apply to such Athletes.
