The Scootering Pro Tour Montpellier is a second-tier Ranking event for the 2023/2024 competition season.

COUNTRY QUOTA & PRE-SEEDED RIDERS

The below country quota is in addition to any pre-seeded riders.

Park & Street:

Men (14+): 6 per country per discipline Women (14+): 6 per country per discipline

There is no World Skate sanctioned Junior competition taking place at this event.

Pre-seeded:

The top 6 riders from each of the Men's and Women's World Rankings are pre-seeded into the competition. Pre-seeded athletes do not count against the country quota and do not pay a registration fee for the relevant discipline they are seeded into.

These athletes will be automatically registered for the event and must <u>not</u> register via their National Federation.

Pre-seeded riders enter the competition at the first round.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Park Qualification, Semi-Final and Final:

2x 40 second runs

Best run counts

Riders can receive a maximum of 100 points for each run

Top 24 progress to the semi-final and then the top 10 progress to the final

Street Qualification and Semi-Final:

2x 40 second runs

Best run counts

Riders can receive a maximum of 100 points for each run

Top 24 progress to the semi-final and then the top 10 progress to the final

Street Final:

2/3/3 format - 2 runs, 3 best tricks, 3 scores count as below:

2x 40 second runs, scored 0-100

3x best trick attempts, scored 0-50

Total score (max 200) = best run score + 2 best trick scores



ATHLETE SAFETY

We remind all participating athletes that physical safety during practice and competition times is paramount. It is recommended that athletes of all ages and disciplines regularly review their protective equipment.

In Park, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for all athletes.

In Street, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for athletes 17 years of age or younger. We strongly encourage athletes to wear a helmet even if not mandatory.

Athletes found to be in violation of safety rules may be penalized with any of the following: reduction of practice time, disqualification from the current competition, or deduction of Ranking points.

VISA

Please note that invitation letters will be issued only after completing the registration process on the World Infinity Platform. No exceptions will be made.



REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store</u> (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes and National Team Officials) must <u>individually sign up</u> in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be <u>registered for the event by their National Federation of</u> belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). Please do not register Pre-Seeded Athletes within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as "Neutral athletes" following the "Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes".

REGISTRATION FEES

Men's & Women's competitions: 100 USD per discipline.

Pre-seeded athletes do not pay a fee for the specific discipline that they are pre-seeded in.



ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021, 2022 and 2023 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the WADA ADEL platform and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the WADA ADEL platform is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

PRIZE MONEY

The total prize purse for the Scootering Pro Tour Montpellier is \$30,000 shared equally across Men's Park, Women's Park, Men's Street and Women's Street. The \$7,500 prize pool for each competition will be broken down as below:

1st: \$3,500 2nd: \$2,000 3rd: \$1,000 4th: \$600 5th: \$400
