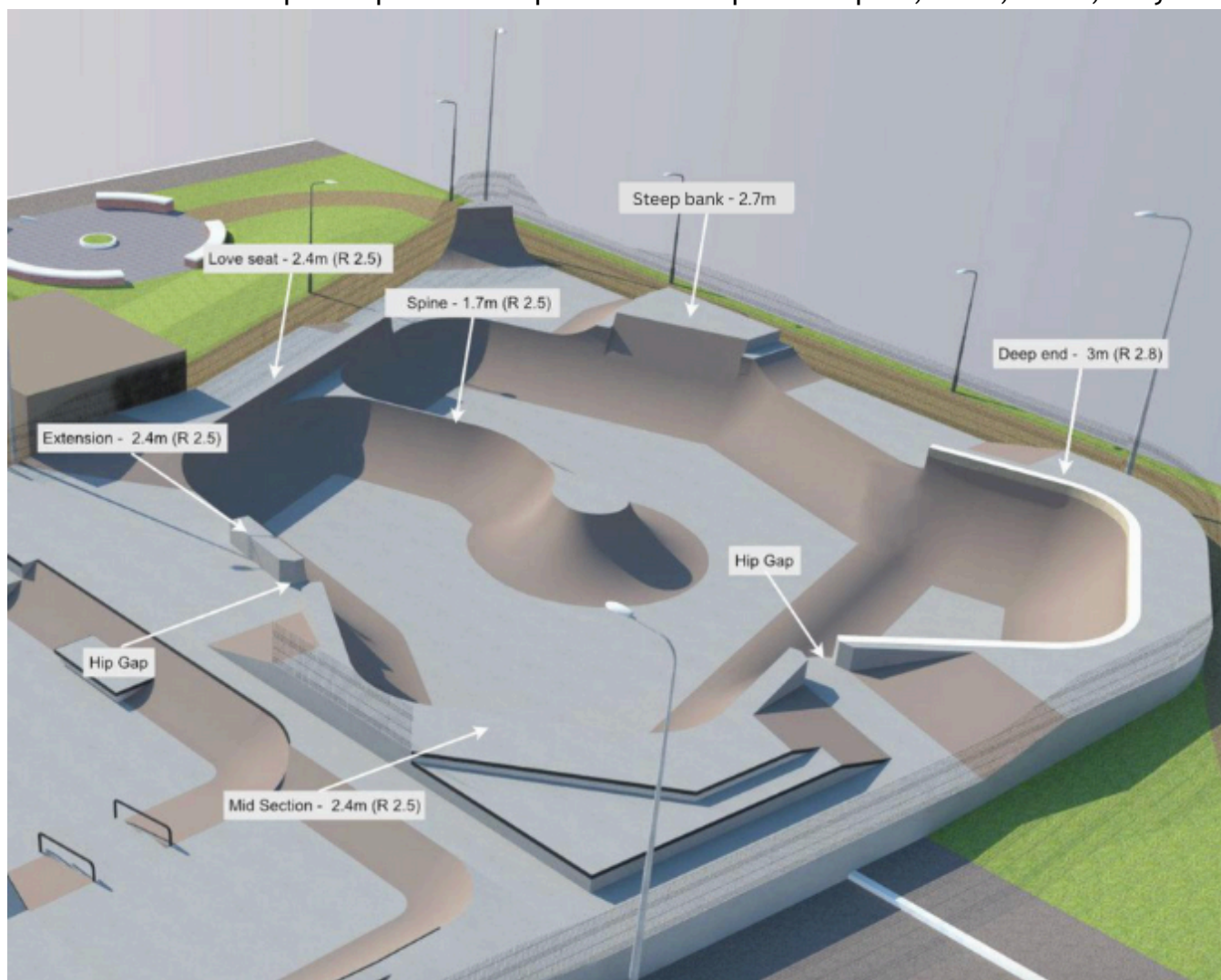
Dear Sir/Madam,

We will be hosting Men's, Women's and Junior competitions in each discipline.

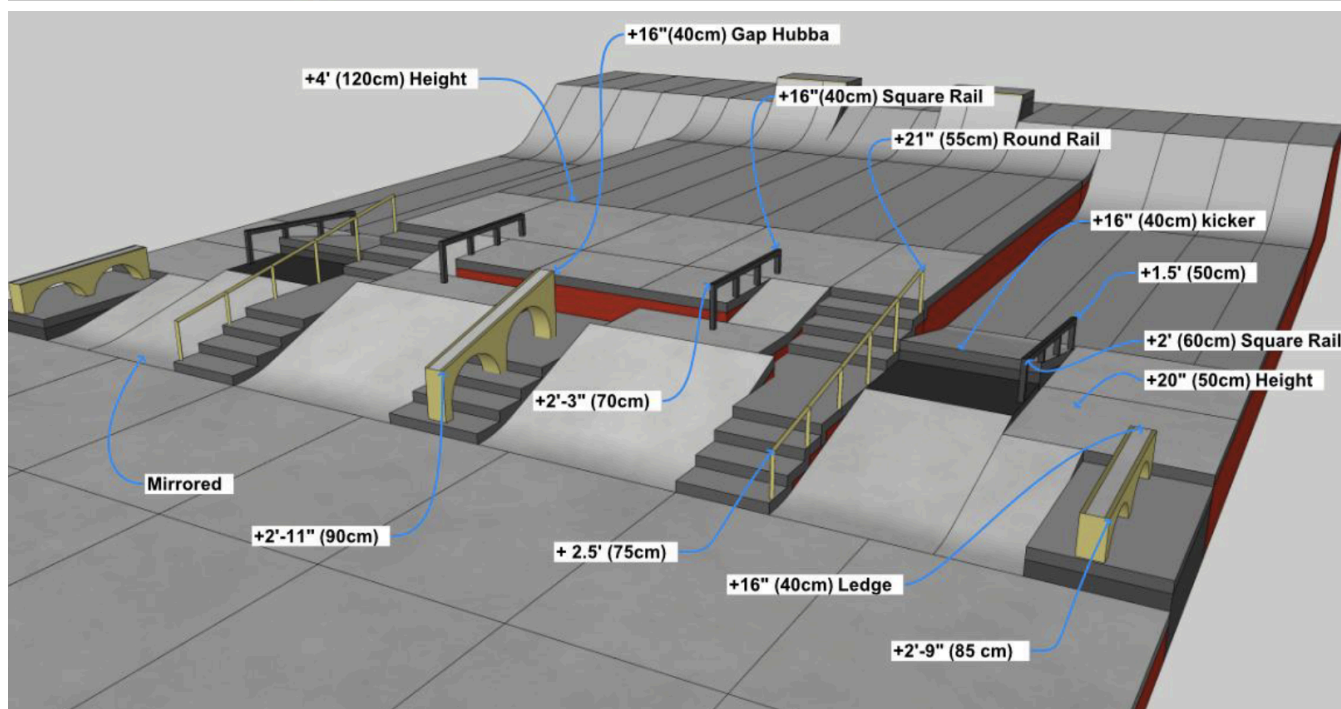
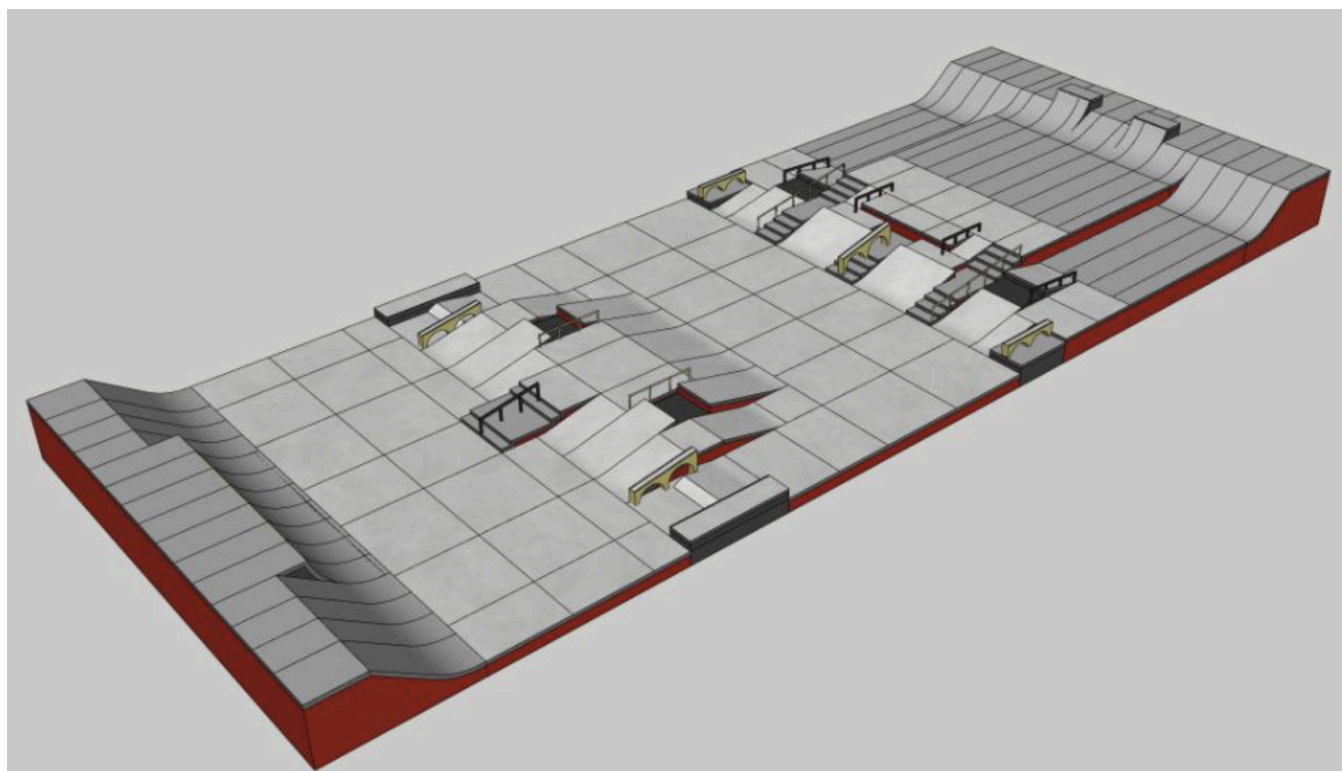
VENUE LOCATIONS & FIELDS OF PLAY

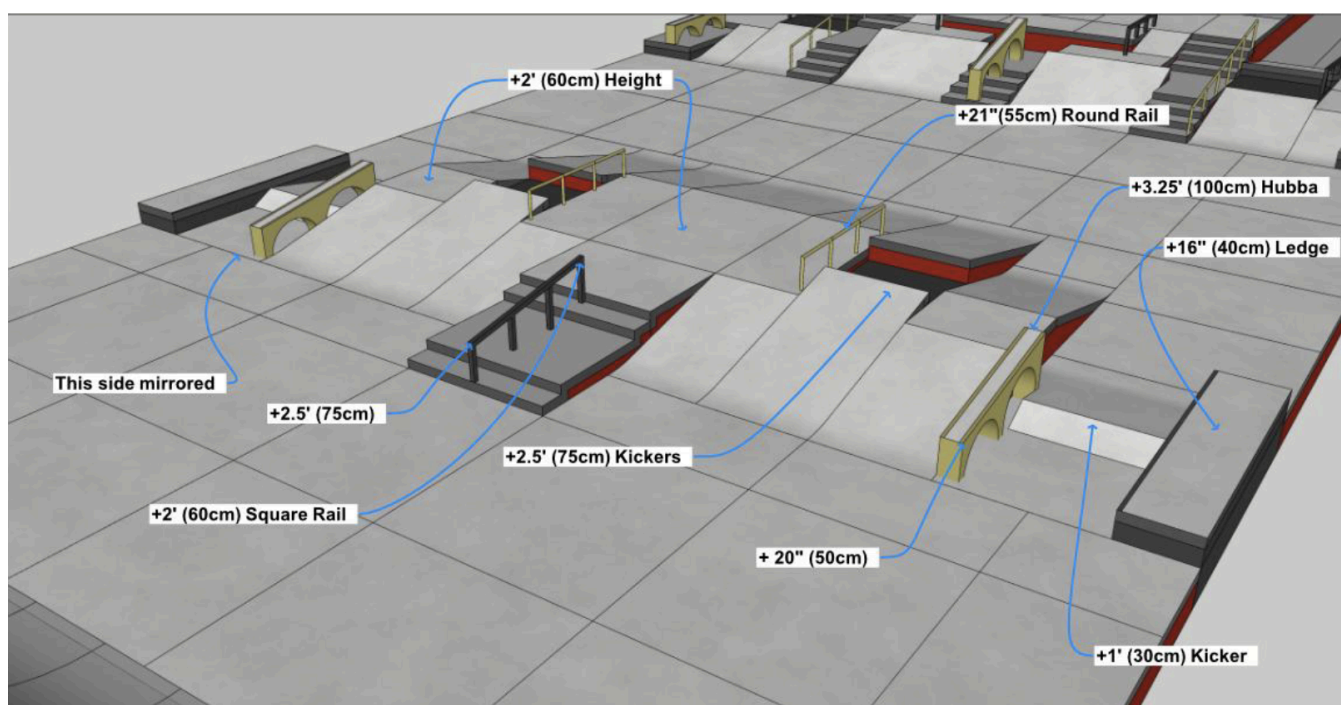
The Park World Championships will take place at: The Spot Skatepark, Ostia, Rome, Italy



The Spot Skatepark will be closed at least 1 week before the first Scootering Park practice session. During this time, access to the park's facilities will be completely unavailable to all athletes and the general public.

The Street World Championships will take place at: Parco del Colle Oppio, Rome, Italy





The FOP will be closed at least 2 weeks before the first Scootering Street practice session. During this time, access to the park's facilities will be completely unavailable to all athletes and the general public.

COUNTRY QUOTA & PRE-SEEDED RIDERS

The quota for a country as below is **in addition** to any pre-seeded riders.

Men (14+): 8 per discipline per country

Women (14+): 8 per discipline per country

Junior (10-17, mixed gender): 4 per discipline per country

Pre-seeded:

The top 8 riders from each of the Men's and Women's World Rankings, and the top 4 riders from the Junior World Rankings, as of 11th June 2024, are pre-seeded into their relevant competition. Pre-seeded athletes do not count against the country quota and do not pay a registration fee for the competition they are seeded into. Pre-seeded riders enter each competition at the first round.

These athletes will be automatically registered for the event and must not register via their National Federation.

If a Junior athlete is still 17 years of age or younger by 11th June 2024, and will turn 18 before the first practice session of their relevant discipline's World Championships, they will be ineligible to compete at the 2024 Junior World Championships. As such, any pre-seeded status will be passed down to the next highest placed Junior athlete in the World Rankings as of 11th June 2024.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Park Qualification, Semi-Final and Final rounds:

2x 40 second runs

Best run counts

Max score 100

Top 30 Men progress to the Semi-final

Top 10 Men, Women and Juniors progress to the Final

Street Qualification and Semi-Final rounds:

2x 45-second runs

Best run counts

Max score 100

Top 30 Men progress to the Semi-final

Top 10 Men, Women and Juniors progress to the Final

Street Final rounds:

2/3/3 format

2x 45-second runs followed by 3 single trick attempts

Runs scored out of 100, tricks scored out of 50 each

Total score combines the best run score with the two best single trick scores

Max score 200

ATHLETE SAFETY (RULEBOOK 2024)

We remind all participating athletes that physical safety during practice and competition times is paramount. It is recommended that athletes of all ages and disciplines regularly review their protective equipment.

In Park, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for all athletes.

In Street, helmets are compulsory at all times during practice sessions and competitions for athletes 17 years of age or younger. We strongly encourage athletes to wear a helmet even if not mandatory.

Athletes found to be in violation of safety rules may be penalized with any of the following: reduction of practice time, disqualification from the current competition, or deduction of Ranking points.

The [Rulebook](#) includes more detailed technical details regarding entry requirements, pre-seeding information, safety equipment, area access, competition formats, practice limitations, judging clarification and much more.

We strongly recommend that all athletes, staff, coaches and other interests familiarize themselves with its contents.

REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.

World Skate Infinity is available on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

Single Users (Athletes and National Team Officials) must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already) with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Once Athletes and National Team Officials have completed their profile on Infinity, they will be eligible to be registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). **Please do not register Pre-Seeded Athletes within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.**

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as “Neutral athletes” following the [“Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes”](#).

REGISTRATION FEES

Men's & Women's: 100 USD per discipline

Junior: 50 USD per discipline

Pre-seeded athletes do not pay a fee for the specific discipline that they are pre-seeded in.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021, 2022 and 2023 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

PRIZE MONEY

The total prize purse for the Park and Street World Championships is \$30,000 shared equally between Men's and Women's categories and both disciplines. The \$7,500 prize pool for each competition will be broken down as below:

- 1st: \$3,500
- 2nd: \$2,000
- 3rd: \$1,000
- 4th: \$600
- 5th: \$400

ACCOMMODATION AND VISA REQUIREMENTS


