Dear Presidents,

following what communicated to us by the Organizing Committee of the World Championships of Nanjing two organizational difficulties have recently emerged:

1. impossibility of realization of a lighting system of the road circuit and the consequent need to finish the road races by 18:00.
2. inability to carry out the road competitions on Saturday, 17/09, because the path is part of the access to the adjacent stadium where at that time there will be a very important football match with the presence of thousands of spectators.

In light of the above, the Organizing Committee has asked us not to use Saturday, 09/17 for road competitions.

It was also suggested to change the venue, but as this is a highly prestigious venue within the Olympic area we thought it right to keep it.

Therefore, to enable us to regularly carry out the entire program of the World Championship, the road races will be held September 14, 15 and 16; Saturday, September 17, will be a day of rest and Sunday, September 18, as scheduled, will be held marathons.

Enclosed is the new schedule of races.

We are sure that you will understand the absolute necessity of the above mentioned changes.


