**Maxim Kruglov, Russian skateboarding athlete, receives 4 years sanction from Russian Anti-Doping Agency (RUSADA).**

The athlete was notified that he needed to provide a sample and was duly informed of the consequences of refusing, however he still refused to undergo the procedure. At the hearing, the athlete was unable to provide convincing arguments of unintentionality of the violation or absence of his fault.

The World Skate Doping Review Panel support the action of the **Russian Anti-Doping Agency** in sanctioning the athlete **Maxim Kruglov**, for a period of **four (4) years starting on February 07 2019 8** ( hearing panel day).

During the period of ineligibility **Maxim Kruglov** is not permitted to participate in any sports related activity with any organisation that is a signatory to the WADA Code including but not limited to competing, train with a team, coaching, committee work but excepting anti-doping education and counselling.

In addition to the period of ineligibility **Maxim Kruglov** forfeits all results, medals, prizes and placements from and including **February 07, 2019**.
