Florent Sorres, French Rink Hockey athlete, receives 18 months sanction from the “Agence Française de Lutte contre le Dopage (AFLD)” for the presence of carboxy-THC, metabolite du cannabis in his sample on March 03, 2019 during a match of the “Coupe de France de Roller Hockey”.

The World Skate Doping Review Panel supports the action of the **AFLD** in sanctioning the athlete Florent Sorres, an international rink hockey athlete, **for a period of 18 months years ending on April 02, 2021.**

During the period of ineligibility **Florent Sorres** is not permitted to participate in any sports related activity with any organisation that is a signatory to the WADA Code including but not limited to competing, train with a team, coaching, committee work but excepting anti-doping education and counselling.

In addition to the period of ineligibility **Florent Sorres** forfeits all results, medals, prizes and placements from and including **March 03, 2019.**
