Florent Sorres, French Rink Hockey athlete, receives 18 months sanction from the "Agence Française de Lutte contre le Dopage (AFLD)" for the presence of carboxy-THC, metabolite du cannabis in his sample on March 03, 2019 during a match of the "Coupe de France de Roller Hockey".

The World Skate Doping Review Panel supports the action of the AFLD in sanctioning the athlete Florent Sorres, an international rink hockey athlete, for a period of 18 months years ending on April 02, 2021.

During the period of ineligibility **Florent Sorres** is not permitted to participate in any sports related activity with any organisation that is a signatory to the WADA Code including but not limited to competing, train with a team, coaching, committee work but excepting anti-doping education and counselling.

In addition to the period of ineligibility Florent Sorres forfeits all results, medals, prizes and placements from and including March 03, 2019.
