Mr Camilo Andres Orozco Fuentes, member of the Colombian Federation, received a four (4) year sports ban starting on 20 June 2018 and ending on 20 June 2022 for supplying erythropoietin to an athlete and providing instruction on its use and administration.

During the period on ineligibility Mr Camilo Andres Orozco Fuentes is banned from participating in any activities at any level in any sport including but not limited to coaching, providing nutritional and medical advice, training advice or other advice in a sport related nature whether on a professional capacity or not. This includes advice provided by any form of communication including verbal, written and electronic means.

Mr Orozco Fuentes is also prohibited from involvement in Federation activities including but not limited to committee, administrative and planning functions.

Under rule 2.10 of the World Skate Anti-Doping Rules any athlete associating with a support person during their period of ineligibility risks a sanction if the association continues after one written warning.

The onus will be on the athlete to establish that the association is not in a professional or sport related capacity.
