## Doping Control

### Requirements for Accreditation World Skate World Championships 2018 Competitive Year

**Scope:** Athletes, coaches, doctors and medical staff, team managers and other support staff

**All participants above must complete and provide**

- ➔ Signed World Skate Acknowledgement and Agreement for Doping Control. The form must be signed by the participant and by a parent or guardian if the athlete is under 18 years old. Completed forms for each participant must be submitted to by National Federations with nomination forms
- ➔ Certificate of completion of an anti-doping education programme. This programme may be provided by a National Anti-Doping Organisation (NADO) or the WADA e- learning programme ALPHA. The certificate should be submitted to World Skate by National Federations together with the nomination forms.
- ➔ ALPHA is available on the WADA webpage [www.wada-ama.org](http://www.wada-ama.org), click on what we do, education.
- ➔ Of the 10 possible anti doping rule violations only 1 depends on a positive test, 5 apply to athletes and 5 apply to athletes and others. You do not need to be tested to attract an anti-doping rule violation (advr)
