## **Organising Hearing for Antidoping Rule Violation (ADRV)**

### **Policy and Procedure**

- On receipt of ADRV via ADAMS the World Skate (WSK) Anti-Doping Officer will immediately check
  - a. TA and RMA on lab report to establish organisation with jurisdiction
  - b. If World Skate is TA and RMA then
- The Anti-doping Officer will check with World Skate and the NADO if there is an applicable TUE
  - a. The World Skate anti-doping officer will check the validity of the TUE including approval and expiry date
  - b. That the levels in the sample are appropriate to the dosage approved for therapeutic use
- The Anti\_Doping officer will check the sample number against the security form and with the lab that all relevant standards have been met

If no TUE is applicable and all standards have been met the anti-doping officer will prepare the notification, B sample request and hearing request form to send to the athlete which should be within 3 working days

The athlete has 7 days to respond

On receipt of request for B sample analysis the anti-doping officer will contact the laboratory to arrange B sample analysis and notify the lab if the athlete will attend or an independent observer is to be arranged.

The athlete will be contacted with arrangement by anti-doping officer within two days

If the athlete does not request B sample analysis a hearing will be offered as soon as possible

If a hearing is not requested the doping review panel will consider the sanction and notify the athlete, WADA, NADO and National Federation within 4 weeks and notify the right of appeal to CAS . Intention to appeal must be lodged to World Skate within 21 days

If the B sample analysis is requested the same process above for the hearing applies if the B sample is positive
