Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUEs) issued by the following National Antidoping Organisations (NADOs) are automatically recognised by World Skate

- SIA (Sport Integrity Australia, previously ASADA) Australia
- NADA Germany
- DFSNZ Italy
- NADO-Italia New Zealand
- USADA United States of America
- CCES Canada
- UK Anti-Doping United Kingdom

International Federations

- ISU International Skating Union

WORLD SKATE will approve TUEs from other ADOs provided that they have been approved in accordance with International Standards for TUE and the medical file is provided by the athletes or is available on ADAMS for review by the World Skate TUE Committee.

In such case, please notify **World Skate** that you have a TUE granted by your NADO.

If your existing TUE does not fall under a category of decision described above, you must submit a request for recognition by **World Skate**. Please refer to the section “How to submit a request for recognition of your NADO’s TUE to **World Skate**?” in World Skate TUE document via link below.

If you are NOT an International-Level Athlete as defined in World Skate Antidoping Rules (ADR) and you have been tested by World Skate a valid TUE granted by your NADO will be recognized provided it satisfies the ISTUE criteria for granting a TUE.

If you are also NOT a National-Level Athlete as defined by your NADO and you have been tested by **World Skate** you must apply for a retroactive TUE to **World Skate**

All criteria for approval of TUE apply to TUEs provided retroactively.
