COMPETITION FORMAT

In the Global Open qualifiers, skaters will compete in maximum 3 skaters, 3 minutes single

jam session format.

The first 10 skaters from the Global Open qualifier ranking will progress to the Quarter Finals.

Event phases after the Global Open Qualifier will be run using the Olympic contest format. Each Skater will perform 2 runs and 5 Tricks; the best 4 scores from runs or tricks will be added to give the total round score.

COUNTRY QUOTAS

Two male and two female skaters per National Federation will be admitted to attend the Street World Championships. Skaters from your country already prequalified to the World Championship because of their placing in the SLS 2018 tour season ranking will not count against your country quotas.

SAFETY GUIDELINES AND RULEBOOK

Athletes must skate using safety gear they deem necessary to guarantee their safety. The mentioned choice shall be made evaluating one's own ability level and style of skating.

Wearing of a helmet is compulsory for athletes under the age of 18. Skaters must be aware of their surroundings at all times and should take precautions to be extra vigilant and considerate of other skaters, especially when on course.

It is recommended that skaters do not wear headphones while practicing in order to avoid collisions, and they may be asked to remove them if they do so.

Specific competition rules, will be released with a separate communication before the event.

EVENT SEEDING 2019 SEASON

World Championship of Street Skateboarding 2018 is the seeding event for season number 1 of the Olympic Qualification System, ending on the 15th of September 2019.

Final rankings (placement) from World Championship 2018 will determine automatic qualification onto 2019 Street League World Tour season-long. Top 38 men based on World Championship final results, will qualify onto 2019 Tour.

The top 24 ranked athletes based on World Championship results are automatically pre-seeded into Semi-Finals, while athletes ranked 25-38 are seeded into quarterfinals at each World Tour stop of season 1 of the qualification period of TOKYO2020 Olympic Games.

Top 10 women based on World Championship final results to qualify onto 2019 Tour.

All Women are pre-seeded into the Semi-Finals.

VISA

*Please consider these requirements might change from country to country, so please check the requirements with Brazilian consulate/embassy of your country.


ANTIDOPING CONTROL
