TOKYO 2020 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

World Skate is pleased to announce that the OI STU Open, to be held in Rio di Janeiro, will be part of the Olympic Qualification Season #2 classified as follow:

Street discipline: 5 Star Park Discipline: Pro Tour

VENUE

The competition will take place at:

Duó Square

St. Perpetual Square, Barra da Tijuca 22620-280 Rio di Janeiro, Brazil

The skateparks will be closed for maintenance and construction between October 16th and November 10th

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register 5 Skaters per gender per discipline. Preseeding skaters will not count against the Country Quota.

EVENT CRITERIA

The event will comprise 3 competition rounds for both Men and Women: Qualifier, Semifinal and Final.

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards might be granted based on, but not limited to, a mix of criteria including competitive results, host country citizenship, prior injuries, and/or a lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin. Wild Cards will be issue at World Skate sole discretion.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an e mail to platform@worldskate.org before October the 30th at 11.59 PM CET



QUALIFIER

The Qualifier round is open to a country quota of 5 athletes per Gender registered by World Skate recognized National Governing Body, and Event Wildcard holding athletes.

SEMIFINAL SEEDING

The top 15 skaters from the World Skateboarding Ranking (WSR) after the World Championships 2019 will be presended in the Semifinal competition round of both disciplines.

Preseeding skaters are required to check in at the registration desk, meeting the following deadline:

Day November 14th at 2:00PM

In case of no-show or inability to skate, athletes supposed to compete in Semifinal will be replaced with next ranked skater from the Qualifier.

Preseeding skaters <u>do not</u> need to be registered in the Sports Entry Registration Platform and are exempted from paying the registration fee.

<u>Attention</u>: Brazilian law provides that the acceptance of minors in hotels is subject to the following rules:

If accompanied by the parents (or one of them), the minor must carry the original identity



or birth certificate or certified copy, provided that the parents are also carrying photo ID;

If the child or adolescent is alone or accompanied by a third part, authorization signed by parents or guardians with notarized signature or judicial authorization is required.
