TOKYO 2020 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

This Event will be classified as Pro Tour, the second top tier of Olympic qualification point earning competitions.

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **5 Skaters** per Gender. Pre-seeded skaters do not count against your Country Quota limit.

EVENT CRITERIA

The event will comprise 3 competition rounds for both Men and Women: Qualifier, Semifinal and Final.

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards might be granted based on host country citizenship and lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin.

Wild Cards will be issued at World Skate sole discretion.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an e mail to platform@worldskate.org before January 24th at 11.59 PM CET.

COMPETITORS ELEGIBILITY

The competition is open to the following athletes:

- Skaters registered by NGBs under the country quota limit of 5 per gender
 - Skaters ranked in the top 15th positions of the World Skateboarding Ranking as of November 22nd, 2019. These athletes are collectively referred as “pre-seeded”:
- Pre-seeded skaters do not need to be registered in the Sports Entry Registration Platform and are exempted from paying the registration fee.
 - Skaters ranked in the WSR from place 6 to 15 are pre-seeded to compete in the Qualifier:

Pre-seeded skaters to Semifinal are required to check in at the competition registration desk by the following deadlines:

- **Thursday February 7th at 16:00pm**

In case of no-show or inability to skate, Pre seeded will be replaced with next ranked skater from the Results of Qualifier phase.

QUALIFIER CUT

A minimum of 25 top ranked athletes from the Qualifier round will advance to the Semifinal.

SEMIFINAL CUT

The top 8 ranked athletes of the Semifinal will advance to the Final.

The above schedule is open to changes according to the number of

registered riders. A final and detailed schedule is going to be published after registrations are closed

COMPETITION FORMAT

In the Qualifiers, skaters will compete in maximum 2 skaters, 2 minutes jam session format.

The first 25 skaters from the Qualifier Ranking will progress to the Semifinal. In case of injury or inability to skate the Semifinal round, qualified skater will be replaced only if the athlete releases his/her qualification spot.

In Semifinal and Final, skaters will compete in the Olympic Street Format with 2 runs and 5 single trick w attempts. Best 4 scores are added and counted for the round score and final ranking.
