Dear friends,

We are pleased to inform you that Skateboarding has been selected and included in the Sport Program of the upcoming Southeast Asian Games to be held in the Philippines, December 2019 with the following disciplines: Street, Park and Downhill.

### **COUNTRY QUOTA**

Number of Entries: The maximum number of entries by a nation in every event is fixed by the Federation. However, the following numbers cannot be exceeded. For each event there shall only be maximum two (2) entries per NOC.

<u>Nationality of Competitor:</u> Only nations of the country of the NOC shall be qualified to represent the NOC in the games. All disputes relating to the determination of the country which competitor may represent in the 30th Southeast Asian Games shall be resolved by the SEA Games Council in accordance with the SEA Games Council eligibility rules.

<u>Participants:</u> The 30th Southeast Asian Games Skateboarding Competition are reserved for teams representing National Olympic Committees affiliated to the World Skate. Only competitors who comply with the conditions laid down in the SEA Games Council and World Skate Rules and the Philippine SEA Games Organizing Committee of the 30th Southeast Asian Games.

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT - STREET**

The competition format will be held in the 2/5/4 Olympic Format. Skaters will compete in heats of 5 to 6 skaters and perform 2 runs of 45 seconds each, followed by 5 single best trick attempts, and wherein their top 4 scores from these 7 attempts will be



aggregated to produce their final overall score.

Each skater in the Heat performs a single attempt at a time and in the Heat's starting order. The Heat of skaters is rotating through completely before moving on to the next attempt in it's order again.

There will be a 5-minute warm up time between each heat. Top 10 or Top 15 skaters advance to the Final round.

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT - PARK**

Competitors will compete in Heats of 6 to maximum 9 skaters selected to Heats in a random order.

Each athlete will be given two 60 second runs through the course. Time of each run is 60 second or until the fall. In case of a rider's fall, next rider in the starting order is up.

Once the first full round of riders in the starting order finish their runs, the second round of runs starts. There will be a 5minute warm up between each Heat. Top 10 or Top 15 riders advance to the Final Round

#### **COMPETITION FORMAT - DOWNHILL**

Race track length will be no less than 1.4 Kms and type of road surface is asphalt.

<u>Practice Round</u>: All competitors are required to complete at least one run during the practice run.

<u>Qualifying Round:</u> Each competitor will be doing a single timed run down the track during the qualifying run. All competitors must provide at least one qualifying attempt.

The competitor's fastest qualifying time will be used to seed/rank them for the race. If the competitor has more than one qualifying time, the competitor's fastest run will be used to seed / rank the competitor for the race.

In the event of a tie in qualifying times: Competitor's second fastest qualifying time.

Competitor's third fastest qualifying time Race 10 Competitors will be registered into a bracket with their seeds / ranking based on the results from qualifying.

There will be a maximum of 4 competitors in each heat, only the top two (2) finishers of each heat advance to the next round.





