TOKYO 2020 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

World Skate is pleased to announce that the Skateboarding Open Lima 2020 will be part of the Olympic Qualification Season #2 classified as follow:

Street: 5 Star Event + Pan-American Continental Championship **Park:** 5 Star Event

COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **5** Skaters per Gender and per Discipline. Pre-seeded skaters do not count against your Country Quota limit.

PRE-SEEDED SKATERS

- Skaters ranked in the **top 15 positions** of the World Skateboarding Ranking are preseeded to the **Semifinal** round as of 7 days of the start of the Open Qualifier round competition.
- Skaters ranked from the 16th to 30th positions of the World Skateboarding Ranking as of March 3rd, 2019 will be pre-seeded to the Open Qualifier.
 - Pre seeded skaters, ranked 1st to 30th are not required to be registered in the Sports Entry Platform. Pre-seeded riders don't count against the country quota.
 - Top 15 skaters are exempted from paying the registration fee.

Pre-seeded skaters to Semifinal are required to check in at the competition registration desk by the following deadline:

• Wednesday April 8th at 15:00pm

In case of no-show or inability to skate, Pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier.



COMPETITION FORMAT

The event will comprise 3 competition rounds for both Men and Women: Qualifier, Semifinal and Final.

The following competition format applies to Street and Park competitions for both genders.

- In the Qualifier round, skaters will compete in a 2 run competition format.
- All event phases after the Qualifier round will use the Olympic competition format.

Details about the competition formats will be announced and published before the event start, once the registration period is completed.

REGISTRATION

Registration will take place through the online World Skate Sports Entry Platform. The platform will open on March 3rd at 00:00 am and will close on March 27th at 11.59 pm (European time).

A new process regarding the collection of data from Athletes and NTOs and the Anti-Doping procedure has been implemented in World Skate Sports Entry Platform. You will receive a communication in this regard before the opening of the registration process.

EVENT WILDCARDS

A limited number of Wildcards might be granted based on Host Country Quota or the lack of an existing and/or recognized NGB in the country of skater's origin. Wild Cards will be issued at World Skate's sole discretion.

All potential Wildcards must be free of sanctions and must apply by sending an e-mail to: <u>platform@worldskate.org</u> before March 27th at 11.59 PM CET.

The invitation letter to participants can be issued only after the completion of the registration procedure to the event.




VENUE
