REGISTRATION

The registration to the different Online Courses available for Judges, Coaches, Technical Specialists and Data Operators will open on **October 17th at 3:00 PM** (Lausanne time).

We remind you that all the classes are open to everyone. There is no limit regarding the quantity of lesson anyone would like to attend.

How to register:

- **National Federations:** can access the registration [here](#) with the credentials received via e-mail on the e-mail address provided in the annual form.

National Federations that have not received the mentioned e-mail must contact us at: academy@worldskate.org.

National Federations must register the Coaches that have been proposed as World Skate Coaches and have been previously approved by the Technical Commission (maximum 2 coaches per level, per discipline). They can decide whether to proceed with the purchase directly as a National Federation or to devolve it to the single participant/s.

- **Single participants:** People who register individually, and not through the National Federation, must click [here](#) to process the registration and purchase the respective courses.

The User Guide to navigate the registration web page will be available to download on the registration website.

LESSONS AND SCHEDULE

The training period is divided in two cycles:

1st cycle: October - February 2020

2nd cycle: February - May 2021

The lessons of the same discipline during cycle 1 and 2 are different lessons, even if they have the same name, they are not a repetition. Only the lessons held on the same date but at different times will teach the same content.

For International Judges, TS and DO, it is mandatory to attend all the lessons per discipline of cycle 1 and 2 to reach a level and to confirm their role (every 4 years).



All the attendees that complete the whole training of their discipline in Cycle 1 and 2 and pass the exam will be recognized as International Judges, TS and DO.

Regarding Coaches proposed as World Skate Coach, appointed by the respective National Federation, only those who have already passed level 1 can access the second level and only those who have passed level 1 and 2 can access level 3. This means that during the academic year 20-21 it is possible to reach only one level, as cycle 2 is correlative to cycle 1.

Clarification:

In the last bulletin we have included the following sentence:

“Lessons will not be registered nor distributed and must NOT be registered using other devices”

The actual meaning of this sentence was “Lessons cannot be recorded by participants using any kind of device and must not be distributed to third parties”

World Skate reserves the right to record the lessons and distribute them as per the terms and conditions of use to be accepted by each participant.

ENTRY FEES

The following information is valid for both cycles:

- **single lesson:** 40 USD
- **2-lessons pack*:** 70 USD

There is no limit to the number of lessons that can be purchased.

The payment method will be PayPal, to be processed directly on the online platform. The system will allow you to use your PayPal account and/or your credit/debit card.

*The 2-lessons pack is applicable to purchase 1 lesson per cycle for the same discipline. This option will be automatically available when you register and purchase the lessons.
