WORLD SKATE ACADEMY: ARTISTIC SKATING

World Skate is glad to announce that the World Skate Academy returns for the academic year 2021-2022 and Online Courses will be available for Judges, Coaches, Technical Specialists and Data Operators.

The Online Courses will be held through the Zoom online platform.

COACHES

There will be lessons for World Skate Coaches Level 1, 2 and 3.

These lessons are open to everyone.

For Level 1 it is expected that the National Federations propose <u>two coaches</u> for each discipline (Free Skating, Pairs, Dance, Precision) to officially start the process to be recognized as World Skate Coach.

Only those who have already passed level 1 can access the level 2 and only those who have passed level 1 and 2 can access level 3.

During the academic year 21-22 it is possible to reach only one level.

At the end of each level there will be an assessment test that will be necessary to access the next level.

Anyone can attend these lessons but only 2 coaches nominated by their National Federations will be officially recognized as World Skate Coaches.

Eventually up to three coaches will be accepted for those nations where for the vastness of the territory need more places to meet the requirements of the project. The Artistic Technical Commission will analyse each situation and will decide if to approve three coaches instead of two.

The eligible candidates must complete the whole training prepared by World Skate (level 1,2 and 3) and pass the exams in order to be recognized internationally as a World Skate Coach.

The Coaches will have the possibility to present courses at a national level, in their own country, with material provided by World Skate.

Please note that the decision to confirm a nominated coach to participate at the World Skate Academy will be solely up to World Skate. The deadline for the National Federations



to send the names and the information requested of the coach/es to artistic@worldskate.org is 10th November 2021.

JUDGES, TECHNICAL SPECIALISTS AND DATA OPERATORS

Only judges, technical specialists and data operators can attend these lessons.

For International Judges, TS and DO, it is mandatory to attend all the lessons per discipline to confirm their role (every 2 years).

LESSONS AND SCHEDULE

The training period is on the following dates:

15 November - 2 March

Participants will have the opportunity to choose between two different kinds of lessons according to their time zone and preferred language.

Live lessons: from 20:00 to 22:30 (CET) in English and Spanish.

Recorded lesson: from 10:00 to 12:30 (CET) only in English. The lesson will not be live, but it will be a recording of the lesson held the day before.

<u>Participants of both lessons will be able to benefit from both Q&A sessions</u>: during the live lesson, the speaker will answer the questions live and the answers will be recorded and played the day after. During the morning lesson, therefore, the participants will be able to listen to the questions and answers of the night session and, of course, to ask new questions. The speaker will reply in a written format and the file with the answers will be sent to ALL participants (of both the night and morning session) within 24 hours from the end of the morning lesson.

REGISTRATION

The registration to the different Online Courses available for Judges, Coaches, Technical Specialists and Data Operators will open on October 31 at 23:59PM (CET).



How to register:

National Federations: can access the registration <u>here</u> with the credentials received last year via e-mail on the e-mail address provided in the annual form.

National Federations that have not received the mentioned e-mails must contact us at: academy@worldskate.org

National Federations must register the Coaches that have been proposed as World Skate Coaches and have been previously approved by the Technical Commission (maximum 2 coaches per level, per discipline). They can decide whether to proceed with the purchase directly as a National Federation or to devolve it to the single participant/s.

Single participants: People who register individually, and not through a National Federation, must click <u>here</u> to process the registration (if they do not have an account yet) or <u>here</u> to sign in and purchase the respective courses.

You can register up to one hour before the start of the lesson.

ENTRY FEES

Following the costs of the lessons:

- Coaches Level 1 pack of 8 lessons: 290 USD
- Coaches Level 2 pack of 8 lessons: 290 USD
- Coaches Level 3 pack of 8 lessons: 290 USD
- New Rules lessons pack of 5 lessons: 180 USD
- Technical Specialists single lesson: 50 USD
- Judges single lesson: 40 USD
- Data Operator single lesson: 40 USD

All the lessons of level (1,2 or 3) can be purchased only and exclusively in a single package of 8 lessons.

Lessons packages can be purchased without limits.

<u>Lessons for Judges can only be purchased by the Judges recognized by the Technical</u> Commission.



<u>Lessons for Technical Specialists can only be purchased by the Technical Specialists</u> recognized by the Technical Commission.

The payment can be processed directly on the online platform by PayPal or credit card.
