ARTISTIC SKATING WORLD CUP 2022

Dear Sirs,

We are glad to announce the upcoming event of the Artistic Skating World Cup 2022. The World Cup consists of the following competitions:

- Two European semifinals
- One American semifinal
- One final

The disciplines allowed to participate are the following: Free Skating, Dance, Solo Dance, Pairs.

The categories are: Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior.

Show and Precision groups only compete in the final.

LOCATION

The first semi-final in Europe will take place in Trieste, Italy.

From 16th to 22nd of May at:

Palapikelc,

Via di Monrupino 32, Trieste.

The second semi-final in Europe will take place in Paredes, Portugal.

From 31st of May to 4th of June at:

Pavilhão Rota dos Móveis,

Paredes, Alameda de Portugal 4580-574 Lordelo PRD

The semi-final in America will take place in Asuncion, Paraguay.

From 13th to 19th of June 2022 at:

Polideportivo SND Arena

Avda. Eusebio Ayala y RI 6 Boquerón Km 5 1/2.

The final will take place in Göttingen, Germany.

More information will be published in the upcoming weeks.

ENTRY RULES FOR SEMIFINALS

For each semifinal, no more than three (3) skaters from within the first six (6) skaters, couples or pairs of the national ranking (of each category/discipline) can enter the competition.

Nations are required to send to World Skate ATC their updated national ranking list one month before the entries for the Cups are open.

The same skaters and teams can take part in the two (2) semifinals per continent. It's not mandatory to take part in both of them, however, the highest Total Technical Score achieved will determine who will be participating in the final.

The Total Technical Score is the sum of the Technical Score of the short/style and the Technical Score of the long/free dance considering also penalties.

In case of tie of Total Technical Score, the total of the score inclusive of the components, will decide the tie.

Quartet Senior, Large Groups, Small Groups and Precision Senior will only participate in the Final.

COUNTRIES NOT BELONGING TO THE CONTINENT OF THE SEMIFINALS

To promote the project and to advantage the countries with difficulties in the organization of local/continental events, skaters representing federations from outside the continent in which the semifinals are organized are very welcome to participate. The entry rules are the same as described in the previous paragraph. **These skaters' scores will NOT be considered in the World Skate Ranking and these skaters' score will NOT be considered in the selection for the World Cup Final.** The only way to qualify for the World Cup Final will be to compete in a Continental Semifinal within the Continent of the federation one represents, or be offered a wildcard as outlined after.

ENTRY RULES FOR FINAL

For skaters or teams that have participated in both continental (area) semifinals, the best Total Technical Scores of the two competitions will be the one considered to qualify for the final.

An overall ranking list will be created with each skater/team's best Total Technical Score from the Semifinals then:

For Free Skating: the first 10 for ladies and first 10 for men (for Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior) with the highest ranked Total Technical Score will proceed to the final.

For Couple Dance: the first 10 couples (both for Junior and Senior) with the highest ranked Total Technical Score will proceed to the final.

For Pairs: the first 10 pairs (both for Junior and Senior) with the highest ranked Total Technical Score will proceed to the final.

For Solo Dance: the first 10 for ladies and the first 10 for men (for Junior and Senior) with the highest ranked Technical Scores will proceed to the final.

Only three (3) entries in each category of each discipline per national will be allowed to qualify for the final. If a nation has more than three (3) skaters/teams listed in the top 10 ranking, the top three (3) will qualify and then the extra places will be filled from other nations according to placement on the ranking list until the ten (10) places for the final are filled.

For Quartets, Large Groups and Small Groups the entry rule is as follows: Three (3) of the first five (5) placed groups in the National Selections are allowed to participate. For Precision, three (3) groups of the first five (5) groups in the national ranking.

Wildcards: If a Continent (Europe, Africa, America, Asia, Oceania) does not have at least one representative in the top ten (10) places for any Junior or Senior event, a Wildcard entry to the final will be granted to one top ranked skater in that event. Wildcards will be offered by World Skate ATC in consultation with the continent involved.

REGISTRATION FEE & MODALITY:

The registration fees are as follows:

SEMIFINALS: 70,00 USD (per skater)

- Free Skating
- Pairs
- Couple Dance
- Solo Dance

FINAL:

80,00 USD (per skater)

- Free Skating
- Pairs
- Couple Dance
- Solo Dance

50,00 USD (per skater)

- Show Groups
- Precision Groups

The registration will take place through the **World Skate Sports Entry Platform**. More details on the registration process will be shared by mid March.

TRAVEL REGULATIONS & COVID PROTOCOL

We invite all participants to be aware of the travel regulations in place in their countries of origin before planning their travel to the event. More details about the Covid situation and requirements to enter each host country will be shared in the next bulletins.

Regardless of the travel requirements and vaccination history, all athletes and officials are allowed to access the venue on the first day after presenting a certificate of negative Covid test carried out by means of a swab (antigen or PCR) in the 24-hours prior to the beginning of the event.


Athletes and officials will be subject to regular testing during the event based on the latest regulations and Covid protocols in place.
