DISQUALIFICATION REPORT

The rules of Park Skateboarding World Championship state the following under safety provisions

Wearing of a helmet is compulsory for athletes under the age of 18. This shall be enforced by the Organizing Committee also during the training/practice sessions. The Contest Director shall not start the competition in the case that Skaters required to wear helmets are not wearing them. Failure to wear a helmet will invalidate any skater's score under the age of 18.

- Competition rules have been made available publicly on-line on World Skate website
- Compulsory helmet wearing rule for athletes under 18 has been repeatedly explained during two Riders and TM Meetings before the competition start
- Compulsory helmet wearing for athletes under 18 has been repeatedly announced by the Event Announcer throughout the event multiple times daily, including Saturday the 3rd of November

Athlete Jagger Eaton has been skating the World Championships Semi Finals, while under age, not wearing a helmet. The Contest director Ryan Clemens failed to prevent the Athlete from competing while not wearing a helmet.

Eduardo Musa, head of delegation of the Brazilian Federation of Skateboarding CBSK, filed a complaint to World Skate Technical Delegate Martin Karas.

After a consultation with the Contest secretary, the Registration Delegate, the Head Judge, the Contest Director and other Technical Commission Members. Taking into account that the human error made by the Contest Director could not be avoided, and the athlete didn't comply to the rules in first place.

The Technical Delegate took the decision, in compliance with the Competition Rules, to disqualify the skater Jagger Eaton from the contest. After that Murillo Peres advanced to the finals by the effect on this decision.
