## FREESTYLE SKATING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

These regulations are laid down for the appointment of staging FIRS Freestyle Skating World Championships and shall ensure the safety and the sports ethic of the event.

### Definition of Freestyle Skating

Freestyle Skating includes 4 different disciplines which are :

- \* Freestyle slalom
- \* Speed slalom
- \* High jump
- \* Free jump

### Judge Team and organization office

Consists of:

- \* 4 official judges nominated by IFSA, including 1 judge manager
- \* 1 event manager in charge of managing & checking the preparation of the competition: Ms LEJEUNE
- \* Organisation staff from the organising committee
- \* 1 Judge appointed by the CIC

The Judge Team has the obligation to perform the proper judgement / organization of the Championship in order to the regulations, including disqualification, exclusion from the event, amendment to the timetable, alteration by reason of an act of god, complaint about track condition.

*Official Language of the World Championship is English*

## **Entry Fees**

The entry fees are to be paid in Euro currency. Amount is to be set by the Organising committee soon.

PAYMENT OF ENTRY FEES : 31<sup>st</sup> August morning for the qualifications & 1<sup>st</sup> September for the finals. Delegates of all attending countries & athletes are kindly requested to be present in order to confirm their entry and nationality, and for the payment too, if not made, of their entry fees. In case of payment made in advance, delegates must send photocopy of payment.

## **Participation at the Freestyle Skating World Championship**

In order to take part at the final of the World Freestyle Skating Championship, skaters must qualified among the qualifications taking place in Russia, France, Spain & Italy, according to the 2007 regulation :

Among the non-qualified skaters :

- \* Freestyle Slalom : top 5 men & top 3 women of each qualification
- \* Speed Slalom : top 5 men & top 3 women of each qualification
- \* Free Jump : top 5 men & top 3 women of each qualification
- \* High Jump : no qualification for the participation to the finals
