



## **2008 FIRS –INLINE HOCKEY REFEREE SEMINAR**

There will be an International Referee course held prior to the 2008 FIRS World Inline Hockey Championships in Dusseldorf, Germany. The course will be run onsite at the World Championships (location of the venue TBA).

The course is open to all Federations who wish to send referee candidates to obtain an International Accreditation. The course runs from 11:30am on July 4<sup>th</sup> and concludes on July 5<sup>th</sup> at 3pm. It is designed for all new Referees. They must attend both days.

### **DAY 1**

**Date:** JULY 4<sup>th</sup>

**Registration:** 11:30am (location TBA) Class begins at 12Noon

**Cost:** \$50.00USD or equivalent. All participants will also be required to pay for all expenses to attend the seminar.

### **DAY 2**

**Class Continues at 8:30am Same Location**

All seminar participants will be accredited at one of the International Levels.

The seminar will serve as a good learning resource for Federations to send candidates to become instructors within their own organizations. The course will go into depth the Inline Playing Philosophy and Game Standards.

**Game Referees who have been selected to attend and Officiate the 2008 World Inline Hockey Championships must attend DAY 2. This is mandatory. There will be no charge to the World Championship referees and this will serve as the Pre-Championship re-fresher course.**


