2008 FIRS Junior Men World Inline Roller Hockey Championship

The Host Federation will be USA Roller Sports and AAU Hockey. The location is in the city of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Keith Noll will be in charge of the Organizing Committee. The dates are firmly set with practice day June 28th and competition will be June 29th through July 2nd. Age qualification for the 2008 Junior Inline Hockey World Championships is at least 14 years but no more than 18 years of age, calculated as of January 1, 2008. In checking passports for age eligibility, CIRILH will use January 2, 1989 to represent the earliest date of birth for the maximum Junior age of 18. Anyone born before that date is too old for Junior. January 1, 1994 represents the latest birth date to achieve the minimum age 14 for either Junior or Senior Divisions. Anyone born after that date is too young. Therefore, the eligibility range for Junior is birth dates inclusive of JAN 2, 1989 to JAN 1, 1994. It is the countries responsibility to ensure that their players are within the age group stated above.
