



EXECUTIVE BOARD RESOLUTION

No. 2/2026

Following the decision adopted by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) Executive Board on 7 July 2026 to provisionally lift the suspension of the Russian Olympic Committee, and the subsequent decision of the IOC that its recommendations to International Federations concerning the participation of Russian athletes and support personnel are no longer applicable, the World Skate Executive Board has voted to lift the restrictions previously imposed on the Russian Federation and Russian athletes and support personnel.

Accordingly, the criteria previously established by World Skate for the participation of Russian athletes and support personnel in World Skate competitions are no longer applicable.

Consequently, Russian athletes and support personnel may participate in World Skate competitions representing their Nation, under the Russian flag and in the national colours, with the Russian national anthem played in accordance with the applicable competition protocols.

World Skate reserves the right to continuously monitor the situation and, where necessary, to request specific documentation, declarations or other supporting information in cases where doubts or concerns arise as to whether any athlete or member of the support personnel has been involved in, or has supported, the war.

World Skate will continue to align its decisions with those of the IOC, while ensuring fairness, impartiality, equal treatment and full respect for the integrity and values of sport.

World Skate remains committed to safeguarding the principles of fair competition and ensuring that all athletes are treated with respect and in accordance with the applicable sporting regulations.
