



EXECUTIVE BOARD RESOLUTION

No. 5/2026

Pursuant to the “One Country-One Federation” principle introduced during the 2019 Congress in Barcelona, and subsequently enshrined in Article 3 of the World Skate Statutes, which provides that “*World Skate recognizes only one National Federation per Country*” and that, “*in Countries where more than one Member Federation has been recognized by World Skate, the different entities shall establish a sole governing body*”, the resulting entity being considered “*as the sole National Governing Body for all World Skate Sports in the relevant Country*”, World Skate has adopted a series of measures aimed at consolidating pre-existing multi-federation structures into a sole National Governing Body for each Country.

In Brazil, the Confederação Brasileira de Skateboarding (“CBSK”) and the Confederação Brasileira de Hóquei e Patinação (“CBHP”, aka Confederação Skate Brasil CSB) have historically been separately recognised by World Skate in relation to different Sports and disciplines governed by World Skate.

In this context, the World Skate Executive Board adopted [Resolution No. 2/2024](#), requiring the consolidation of the governance of all World Skate Sports and disciplines in Brazil under a single national structure in accordance with the World Skate Statutes and By-Laws.

Following the adoption of Resolution No. 2/2024, CBSK filed an appeal before the Court of Arbitration for Sport of Lausanne. Consequently, the implementation of the Resolution and the related governance consolidation process were put on hold pending the resolution of the CAS proceedings.

While those proceedings were pending, CBSK and CBHP, with the involvement of World Skate and the Brazilian Olympic Committee (“COB”), engaged in discussions aimed at reaching an agreed and definitive solution concerning the governance and representation of all World Skate Sports and disciplines in Brazil.



Those discussions resulted in the conclusion of an Agreement & Final Settlement dated 28 January 2026 between CBSK and CBHP and ratified by World Skate and the COB.

Without prejudice to the confidentiality of its specific terms, the Agreement & Final Settlement provides for the establishment of a unified governance structure under the name “Skate Brasil”, intended to become the sole National Governing Body, sole World Skate Member Federation and sole interlocutor of World Skate in Brazil for all current and future Sports and disciplines governed by World Skate.

On 15 July 2026, CBSK and CBHP approved the establishment of Skate Brasil, together with its Bylaws and governing bodies for the 2026-2028 term. The relevant documents were filed with the competent Brazilian authorities on 17 July 2026, and their registration, including the issuance of the CNPJ, remains pending and beyond the control of the sporting entities involved.

Until those formalities have been completed, Skate Brasil cannot yet independently and validly perform all the legal, administrative and financial activities required for the full exercise of its functions.

Having regard to the foregoing, the World Skate Executive Board has approved the ratification of the unified governance structure resulting from the Agreement & Final Settlement and from the Foundation Assembly of 15 July 2026, subject to the completion of the legal and administrative formalisation of Skate Brasil under Brazilian law.

Accordingly, the World Skate Executive Board resolves as follows:

1. Pursuant to Article 3.4 of the World Skate Statutes and Paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2 of the World Skate By-Laws, the new unified governance structure agreed between CBSK and CBHP and established through the Foundation Assembly of 15 July 2026, is hereby ratified.
2. Skate Brasil is designated as the sole National Governing Body and sole World Skate Member Federation in Brazil for all current and future Sports and disciplines governed by World Skate. The full legal and operational effectiveness of such designation and recognition shall be



subject to the completion of the ongoing formalisation process under Brazilian law, including the registration of the relevant corporate documents, the issuance of the CNPJ and the completion of any other applicable administrative formalities. CBSK and CBHP shall keep World Skate promptly informed of the progress of the relevant procedures and shall provide the World Skate General Secretariat with official documentary evidence of their completion.

3. Pending the completion of those procedures, any Brazilian participation or representation within World Skate, whether at sporting or institutional level, shall be registered, accredited, presented and identified exclusively under the generic country designation “Brazil”.

In particular, at the World Skate Games ASU 2026 and at the forthcoming World Skate Congress, all Brazilian athletes, teams, officials, delegates and other representatives shall participate and be identified exclusively as “Brazil”. No separate representation, designation or accreditation of CBSK or CBHP shall be permitted in connection with either event.

This temporary arrangement shall not constitute or imply the separate recognition of CBSK or CBHP, nor shall it prejudice or alter the unified governance structure ratified through this Resolution. It is adopted solely to ensure the continuity of Brazilian sporting and institutional representation while the formalisation process remains pending, in a spirit of cooperation and with the common purpose of ensuring the fullest possible compliance with the World Skate Statutes, By-Laws, Rules and Regulations.

4. Upon receipt and verification by the World Skate General Secretariat of official documentary evidence confirming the completion of the formalisation process under Brazilian law, the designation and recognition of Skate Brasil as the sole National Governing Body and sole World Skate Member Federation in Brazil shall automatically become fully effective.

Consequently, with effect from that same date, CBSK and CBHP shall cease to be separately recognised as Member Federations or National Governing Bodies within World Skate, and their respective World Skate memberships shall automatically cease. Thereafter, Skate Brasil shall hold the sole and unified World Skate membership for Brazil. This determination concerns exclusively the separate status of CBSK and CBHP within World Skate and shall not affect their legal existence under Brazilian law or their respective roles within the unified governance structure of Skate Brasil, in accordance with the Agreement & Final Settlement.



No further resolution or decision of the World Skate Executive Board shall be required for such purpose. This Resolution shall constitute the definitive confirmation and ratification of the unified governance structure of Skate Brasil pursuant to Article 3.4 of the World Skate Statutes and Paragraphs 2.1 and 2.2 of the World Skate By-Laws.

Adopted by electronic vote, pursuant to Article 8.16 of the World Skate Statutes and Paragraph 6.D of the World Skate By-Laws.
