Anti-Doping Rule Violations (ADRVs)

We welcome the 2021 WADA Code, 2021 World Skate Antidoping Rules and the 2021 WADA International Standards because

- Their primary focus is enhancing athlete health and wellbeing
- There is greater accountability for antidoping organisations creating a fairer balance between responsibilities of athletes and those of testing agencies

The 2021 Code has increased the number of ADRVs from 10 to 11. Now any discouragement, intimidation or attempted intimidation of “whistleblowers” or informers is an ADRV under the code.

Administrators, staff, medical personnel, board members and others are now covered under the Code as “people” and can be subject to ADRVs.

2.5 Tampering now includes giving false information at any stage in the doping control process.

2.10 Prohibited Association with a disqualified support person has been amended – the anti-doping organisation is no longer obliged to warn the athlete or other person that they may be associating with a “prohibited” person but they must establish that the athlete or other person knew of the athlete support person’s disqualified status

		2.9 Complicity or attempted complicity by an athlete or other person Assisting, encouraging, covering up
		2.10 Prohibited Association by an athlete or other person
		2.11 Acts by an athlete or Other Person to discouraging, or retaliate against reporting to anti-doping authorities
