

ISE Roles and Responsibilities for IFs

Roles

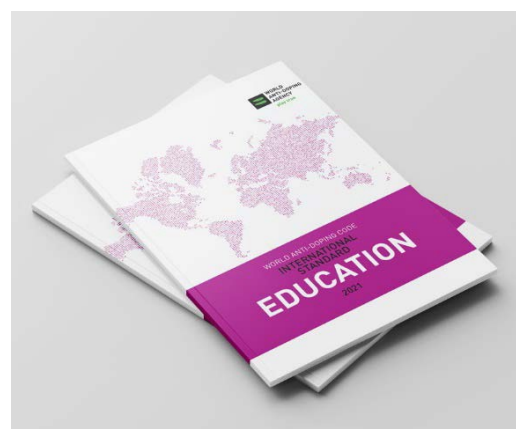
Plan, implement, monitor and evaluate, and promote Education Programs in cooperation with other Anti-Doping Organizations (ADOs) as outlined in the ISE

Require NFs to conduct education in cooperation with their NADOs.

May have a role in educating non-international-level athletes and athlete support personnel under your authority.

Instruct organizations that conduct event-based education programs on behalf of your IF that it must be done in accordance with the ISE.

Support that an athlete's first experience with anti-doping with through education rather than testing.



Responsibilities

Develop an education program for those under your jurisdiction and in your Education Pool

Document an education plan to show how your education program will be implemented and monitored.

Evaluate your education programs annually

Consider delivering event-based education, in cooperation with the local National Anti-Doping Organization (NADO), Regional Anti-Doping Organization (RADO), NF and/or Major Event Organizer (MEO), at international events where you are the testing authority.

Provide athletes and athlete support personnel with education in advance of an international-event.
