PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are pleased to announce that both Street and Park World Championships 2022 will take place at **Sharjah**, the third-most populous city in the **United Arab Emirates**.

The **Street World Championships** will take place from **January 29**th **to February 5**th, and represent the second Street qualification event towards Paris 2024.

The **Park World Championships** will be the first park event on the qualification path towards Paris 2024 and will take place from **February 5th to 12th**.

Both events are classified as World Championships.

VENUE

The competitions will take place at:

Aljada Skate Park Aljada Discovery Centre Aljada Muwailih Commercial Sharjah (UAE)

Although these are open to delegations to visit and skate, the organizers advise that both the competition skateparks will be closed for events' infrastructures set up and preparation between Jan 15th to 28th, 2023. During this closure, the community skatepark area will be available to skate in Sharjah and, in addition to them, we would like to mention that Dubai has a variety of skateparks open for skateboarding.



INVITATION LETTERS AND VISA

We recommend you check the travel regulations in place before making travel plans to the United Arab Emirates, based on your country of origin.

Dnata Agency is the official travel agency in charge of logistics aspects for athletes and NGBs, including VISAs. You can either apply for a VISA on your own by contacting the Embassy of your country or book the service through the official agency- that will do it on your behalf for a small fee.

Requesting the service through the agency is highly recommended as it speeds up the process. To book this service and/or to request an invitation letter, please register through the World Skate Platform and later contact <u>tradecentre@dnata.com</u>



COUNTRY QUOTA

National Federations are allowed to register **6 athletes** per gender per discipline. Pre-seeded skaters and the skaters with the right to compete (ranked 6th to 30th) do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations don't need to register pre-seeded skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

STREET SEEDING STRUCTURE

The TOP 5 ranked athletes in the <u>Olympic World Skate Ranking (OWSR)</u> as of today, will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into the following competition phase.

Skaters ranked 6th to 30th will be seeded to the **Open Qualifier**.

All skaters must complete the event check-in no later than the day before the first phase of the competition. Meaning, Qualifier phase (based on gender schedule, as follows), this deadline will also be applied to skaters pre seeded in the Quarterfinals.

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next-ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

• ALL pre-seeded skaters (ranked 1st to 30th) are required to sign up to Infinity and create their own profile, same as all participants. However, their respective Federations will have to confirm or refuse their participation within Infinity and pay the registration fee. They will <u>not</u> count against their National Federation's country quota. <u>Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR) are exempted from paying the registration fee.</u>

However, their respective Federations will have to confirm or refuse their participation within Infinity and pay the registration fee. They will <u>not</u> count against their National Federation's country quota. <u>Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR and Tokyo 2020 medalists) are exempted from paying the registration fee.</u>

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, our new Sports Registration Platform and will be open <u>from December 15th 2022 at 00.00am (CET) to</u> <u>January 16th 2023 at 11.59pm (CET).</u>

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store (Android)</u> and <u>App Store (iOS)</u>.

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents; passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version).

In case of an Anti-Doping Course Certificate released before 2020 or should anyone need to take the course, here's the link to WADA's ADEL platform: https://adel.wada-ama.org/learn.

We remind you that WADA's ADEL Platform is not managed by World Skate, therefore all support requests must be sent directly to WADA.

In case of underage single users (under 18 years old), they will need the assistance of a



parent/legal guardian who will also have to submit his/her data and Passport copy.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration. For more details regarding the single user sign up process, please watch this video: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=meHkSVuitUI.

Each NF has the right to register the same number of NTOs for each discipline (Street and Park). Meaning: if a NTO is registered only for Park, he/she will not be allowed to enter for Street and vice versa. NTOs participating in both disciplines need to be registered twice.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.

National Federations must confirm <u>all Athletes</u> as their members within Infinity (desktop version), otherwise they will not be able to register them for the event.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within January 13th
2023.

Please note that the status of a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to these cases as per "2022 WS Skateboarding - Competition Rules":

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking <u>here</u>.

Only **one legal guardian or parent** per minor athlete can be registered.

Only after completing the registration should they follow the procedure explained above to obtain the Visa if needed.

Registration deadline is January 13th 2023.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

ACCOMODATION AND OTHER SERVICES

Flight bookings, official hotels, transfers, and visa services can be booked through dnata Travel Management.

ENTRY FEE

Each participating athlete in the Open Qualifier will pay the following fee: 200 USD Please find the payment methods on the registration platform.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards



for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2020, 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
