#### REGISTRATION

The registration window is now open until 31st May 2023!

#### Registering pre-seeded athletes

Pre-seeded athletes do not need to be registered by their National Federation. World Skate Infinity will automatically register these athletes, and the National Federation will later confirm their attendance via Infinity.

## All other athletes and staff

Athletes, staff and delegates must register via Infinity

#### Registration without a National Federation

For athletes without a National Federation, or if the National Federation does not govern scootering, please see the Wild Cards section below.

#### **FEES**

The registration fees are as follows and are the same for each of Park and Street. Athletes wishing to compete in both disciplines will pay two registration fees.

Men's and Women's contests: \$100 per entry

Juniors' contests: \$50 per entry

This payment is only requested after a National Federation confirms attendance of an athlete.

Pre-seeded athletes do not pay a fee for the specific contest they are seeded into.

#### WILD CARDS

Wild Cards are strictly available to athletes from countries without a National Federation, or if the existing National Federation does not govern scootering.



If a country is not represented by a National Federation, then individual athletes may apply for a Wild Card. All applications will be considered based on various factors, but Wild Cards will be strictly limited. Therefore, we strongly recommend that no travel or accommodation is booked until all applications have been reviewed and Wild Cards have been assigned. The relevant athletes will be notified directly if they have been awarded a Wild Card.

Applications are made by contacting <u>platform@worldskate.org</u> with the following information:

- Name
- Gender
- Age
- Nationality
- Desired age category (Junior or Men's/Women's)
- Desired discipline (Park or Street)

The deadline for approving Wild Cards is 15th May 2023.

## AGE REQUIREMENT CHANGE

We have corrected the way age is measured in order to align with other sports within World Skate.

Age is counted by birth year, not by specific date. For categorisation purposes, athletes are treated as though their birthday falls on 31st December 2023. This means that athletes born in 2005 are counted as 17 years of age, regardless of their day and month of birth, and are therefore still eligible for Junior competitions.

In previous documentation, birthdays were counted as 1st January 2023, so athletes born in 2005 would've been counted as 18.
