PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are pleased to announce that Street Pro Tour 2023 will have a stop in Rome - Italy.

This **Pro Tour** event will take place from **June 18**th **to 25**th, and represents the third Street qualification event towards Paris 2024.

VENUE

COUNTRY QUOTA



Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register 6 athletes per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the skaters with the right to compete (ranked 6^{th} to 30^{th}) do not count against the Country Quota registration threshold.

National Federations don't need to register pre-seeded skaters and shall only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to <u>platform@worldskate.org</u> within <u>June 1st 2023</u>.

Please note that wild cards are granted at World Skate's discretion and are limited to the cases below as per "2022_23 WS Skateboarding - Competition Rules":

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in an athlete's country of origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

Each NF has the right to register the same number of National Team Officials.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.



EVENT CHECK-IN

All skaters must complete the event check-in <u>no later than 2 days before</u> the first phase of the competition. This deadline will also be applied to pre seeded skaters.

- Women June 19th 2023 at 06:00 pm
- Men June 20th 2023 at 06:00 pm

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

SEEDING STRUCTURE

The TOP 5 ranked athletes in the <u>Olympic World Skate Ranking (OWSR)</u> as of today will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into the next competition phase.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, and will be open from May 22nd 2023 at 00.00am (CET) to June 8th 2023 at 11.59pm (CET).

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store</u> (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes through World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). Please do not register Pre-Seeded Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

MINORS' PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minors' (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking here.

Only one legal guardian or parent per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is **June 8th 2023.**

Legal guardians/parents are expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

<u>Please note</u> that providing your data and Passport as a verification process for minor skaters' profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

INVITATION LETTERS AND VISA

We recommend you check https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en, where a questionnaire will indicate whether a VISA is required for traveling to Italy from your country.

- Should you require a VISA, please fill out <u>Annex 1</u> with all the necessary information
 and email it to <u>internazionale@fisr.it</u> and <u>operations@worldskate.org</u>. A protocol number
 will be issued to you by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI), which you
 will need to provide to your local consulate or embassy when requesting your VISA so
 that the process can be expedited.
- Should you not require a VISA, and if you are in need of a generic invitation letter,
 please complete <u>Annex 1</u> with all the necessary information and send it to
 <u>internazionale@fisr.it</u>. An invitation letter will be sent to you by the Local Organizing
 Committee.

<u>Please note that invitation letters can be issued only after performing the registration on the new World Skate Sports Entry Platform "Infinity". No exceptions can be made.</u>



ACCOMODATION AND OTHER SERVICES

Note:

- In order to guarantee the rates on the brochure within its availability, LOC advises to contact the hotel before May 2^{nd}
- Hotels suggested by the local organizer each have different contacts for reservation.
- Hotel rates are inclusive of shuttle services to and from the venue, and this is the only way to receive these services.

ENTRY FEE

Each participating athlete in the Open Qualifier will pay the following fee: 200 USD Payments will be processed through Infinity with credit card or bank transfer.

<u>Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR) are exempted from paying the registration</u> fee.



ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analyses will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021 and 2022 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
