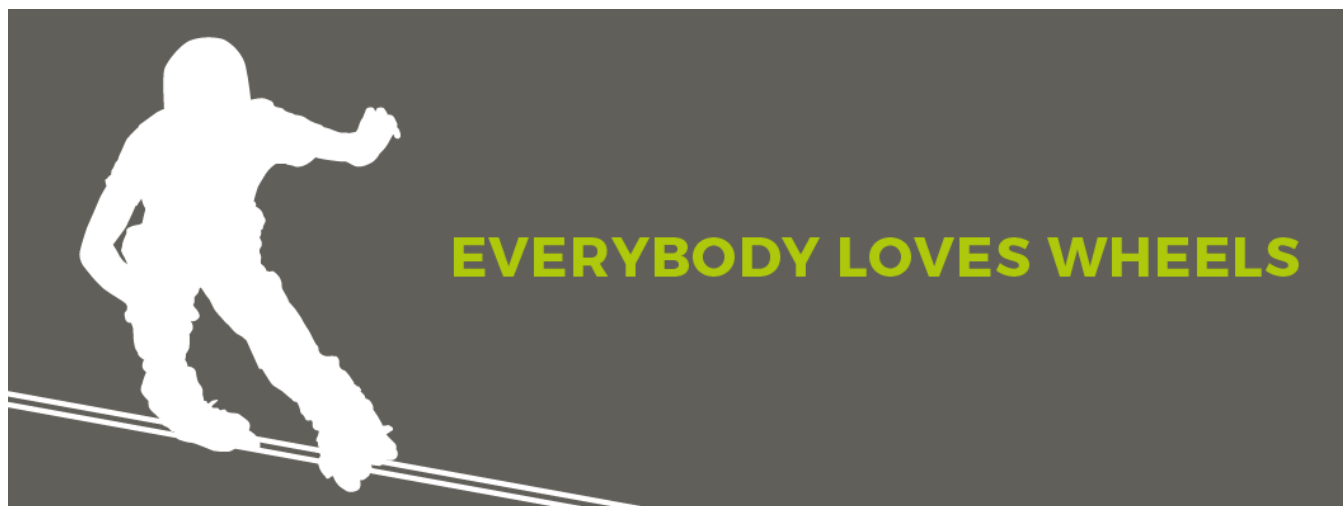

4 heats of 6 riders

2 runs/rider

50 seconds/run

Best run counts

FINAL:

The top 12 riders from the semi final reverse ranking will participate in the final

2 heats of 6 riders

2 runs/rider

50 seconds/run

Best run counts

JUDGING CRITERIA

The performance of each rider is judged on overall impressions, but not limited to:

- Difficulty
- Height
- Flow
- Fluidity
- Originality
- Creativity
- Style
- Consistency
- Variety of tricks
- Landings
- Control of the tricks
- Use of the park

- Execution
- Progress

Please note that each judge can give each rider a score between 0.00 and 99.99. The final score is an average of all the judge's scores.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

All athletes and staff members must complete a valid Anti-Doping Training Course and send the Certificate obtained to antidopinghq@worldskate.org. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021 and 2022 are accepted.
