PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are pleased to announce that the **World Skateboarding Tour Lausanne Street 2023** will have a stop at **Lausanne** in **Switzerland**.

This **Pro Tour** event will take place from **September 9th to 16th**, and represent the fourth Street qualification event towards Paris 2024.

COUNTRY QUOTA

Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register **6 athletes** per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the skaters with the right to compete (ranked 6th to 30th) do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations don't need to register pre-seeded skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within **August 13th 2023**.

Please note that a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited only to these cases below as per "2022_23 WS Skateboarding - Competition Rules":

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

Each NF has the right to register the same number of National Team Officials.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.

EVENT CHECK-IN

All skaters must complete the event check-in no later than 2 days before the first phase of the competition. Meaning, Qualifier phase (based on gender schedule, as follows), this deadline will also be applied to skaters pre seeded in the Quarterfinals.

- Women September 10th 2023 at 06:00 pm
- Men September 11th 2023 at 06:00 pm

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

SEEDING STRUCTURE

The TOP 5 ranked athletes in the [Olympic World Skate Ranking \(OWSR\)](#) as of today will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into the next competition phase. Skaters ranked 6th to 30th will be seeded to the Open Qualifier.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, and will be open **from July 20th 2023 at 00.00am (CET) to August 22nd 2023 at 11.59pm (CET).**

World Skate Infinity is available on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). **Please do not register Pre-Seeded Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.**

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

Please note that a new field will be added in your Infinity profile: “Hometown”. We kindly ask you to fill it in before the beginning of the event. Otherwise, it will be automatically filled in with the last Hometown you declared at the event. This information can be changed in case of mistakes.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking [here](#).

Only one legal guardian or parent per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is **August 20th 2023**.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

Please note that providing your data and Passport as a verification process for minor skaters' profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

AIRPORT

GENEVA AIRPORT // (GVA) - 45min, direct by train

Geneva has a special place among European airports. It has an excellent network of 142 direct destinations, including 23 intercontinental flights. It is connected to the Swiss rail network and is 45 minutes by road to Lausanne.

ZURICH AIRPORT // (ZRH) - 2h 30min, direct by train

Zurich is the main and largest international airport in Switzerland. It is based in the German speaking part of the country but offers many destinations and is well connected via the Swiss rail network and is 2hours and 30 minutes by road to Lausanne.

INVITATION LETTERS AND VISA

Please note that invitation letters can be issued only after completing the event registration on the Infinity App.

ENTRY FEE

Each participating athlete in the Open Qualifier will pay the following fee: 200 USD
Please find the payment methods on the registration platform.

Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR) are exempted from paying the registration fee.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021, 2022 and 2023 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


