PARIS 2024 QUALIFYING SYSTEM STATUS

We are pleased to announce that the **WST Rome Park World Championships 2023** will be hosted at **Rome** in **Italy**.

This will be the **World Championships 2023** for Park discipline taking place from **October 1st to 8th**, and represent the third Park qualification event towards Paris 2024.

VENUE

The competitions will take place at: Via Nostra Signora di Bonaria, 13, 00121 Lido di Ostia RM <u>The Spot Skatepark - Google maps</u>

Spot Skatepark will be closed for maintenance and infrastructure setup from September 23 to 30, 2023. During this time, access to the park's facilities may be limited or completely unavailable.

INVITATION LETTERS AND VISA

We recommend you check <u>https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en</u>, where a questionnaire will indicate whether a VISA is required for traveling to Italy from your country.

- Should you require a VISA, please fill out <u>Annex 1</u> with all the necessary information and email it to <u>internazionale@fisr.it</u> and <u>operations@worldskate.org</u>. A protocol number will be issued to you by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI), which you will need to provide to your local consulate or embassy when requesting your VISA so that the process can be expedited.
- Should you not require a VISA, and if you are in need of a generic invitation letter, please complete <u>Annex 1</u> with all the necessary information and send it to <u>internazionale@fisr.it</u>. An invitation letter will be sent to you by the Local Organizing Committee.

<u>Please note that CONI protocols invitation letters can be issued only after performing the</u> <u>registration on the new World Skate Sports Entry Platform "Infinity". No exceptions can</u> <u>be made.</u>

COUNTRY QUOTA

Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register 6 athletes per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the skaters with the right to compete (ranked 6^{th} to 30^{th}) do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations don't need to register pre-seeded skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within September 11th 2023.



Please note that a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited only to these cases below as per "2022_23 WS Skateboarding - Competition Rules":

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

WORLD SKATEBOARDING COMMISSION - BULLETIN

WORLD SKATE

All skaters must complete the event check-in <u>no later than 2 days before</u> the first phase of the competition. Meaning, Qualifier phase (based on gender schedule, as follows), this deadline will also be applied to skaters pre seeded in the Quarterfinals.

- Women October 2nd 2023 at 06:00 pm
- Men October 3rd 2023 at 06:00 pm

For those with issues on Registration/Check-in, please contact: platform@worldskate.org.

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, and will be open <u>from August 28th 2023 at 00.00am (CET) to September 18th 2023 at 11.59pm (CET).</u>

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store (iOS)</u>.

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). <u>Please do not register Pre-Seeded</u> <u>Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be</u> <u>added and confirm (or not) their participation.</u>



Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

<u>Please note</u> that a new field will be added in your Infinity profile: "Hometown". We kindly ask you to fill it in before the beginning of the event. Otherwise, it will be automatically filled in with the last Hometown you declared at the event. This information can be changed in case of mistakes.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking <u>here</u>.

Only one legal guardian or parent per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is September 18th 2023.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

<u>Please note</u> that providing your data and Passport as a verification process for minor skaters' profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.



Each participating athlete in the Open Qualifier will pay the following fee: 200 USD Please find the payment methods on the registration platform.

Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR) are exempted from paying the registration fee.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021, 2022 and 2023 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
