COUNTRY QUOTA

Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register 6 athletes per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the skaters with the right to compete (ranked 6th to 30th) do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations don't need to register pre-seeded skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within <u>November</u> <u>15th 2023</u>.

Please note that a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited only to these cases below as per "2022_23 WS Skateboarding - Competition Rules":

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

The National Federations (NFs) are entitled to register a specific number of National Team Officials (NTOs), listed above. NFs with a large contingent of competing athletes may apply for additional NTO quotas, pending approval by World Skate.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.

If you encounter any problems with registration or for any reason won't be able to check-in by the above listed deadlines, please seek late check-in waiver approval writing to platform@worldskate.org. While competition management will make every effort to accommodate requests, late check-in waivers are granted at the sole discretion of World Skate.

In case of no-show or inability to compete, pre-seeded skaters will be replaced with the next ranked rider from the Open Qualifier results.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through World Skate Infinity, and will be open from October 23rd 2023 at 00.00am (CET) to November 22nd 2023 at 11.59pm (CET).

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store</u> (iOS).

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version). Please do not register Pre-Seeded Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.

Any single user who fails to complete the above-mentioned steps will not be eligible for event registration.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking <u>here</u>.

Only one legal guardian or parent per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is **November 15th 2023.**

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

<u>Please note</u> that providing your data and Passport as a verification process for minor skaters' profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

ENTRY FEE

Each participating athlete in the Open Qualifier will pay the following fee: 200 USD Please find the payment methods on the registration platform.

<u>Pre-seeded skaters (1st to 5th from the OWSR) are exempted from paying the registration</u> fee.



ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2021, 2022 and 2023 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
