COMPETITION FORMAT UPDATE

The run length in the Final rounds of Street and Park competitions will be extended to 45 seconds. All other aspects of the competition formats, as seen in <u>Bulletin#01</u>, remain unchanged.

INFINITY

All key information, heat lists, competition results and other updates will be published using the Infinity app. It is strongly recommended that all athletes and officials turn on notifications within the app to receive live updates.

Infinity is also required to check in all athletes and officials.

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store (Android)</u> and <u>App Store (iOS)</u>.



EVENT CHECK-IN

To access the Street or Park Field(s) of Play, athletes must first check in at the accreditation office within the "Zone Roller-Trotinette", situated next to the Park FOP indicated below. On Tuesday 7th May, access to the festival is only possible via the "Accueil/Accredités" entrance.





ENTRY INFORMATION

Each athlete will require two accreditation types: one to enter the festival and another to access the Field(s) of Play. Festival entry is free for all competing athletes and the entry credential will be sent to each athlete, via the email address used on Infinity, directly from FISE/Hurricane. This allows access to the event, after which all athletes must collect their Competition credential at the accreditation office in order to access the Field(s) of Play.

If athletes have not yet received their festival credential, including in their spam inbox, please contact sports@hurricane-agency.com.

Only athletes receive free access to the festival. All other parties must purchase a ticket from the <u>FISE website</u>.

On Tuesday 7th May, only athletes and eligible companions will be allowed to enter the festival for the practice sessions. From Wednesday 8th May until Sunday 12th, the event is open to all other parties and the public, who will require a valid festival pass to enter.

COMPANION FOR UNDER 18s

A maximum of one companion will be allocated per athlete under 18 years of age, and must check in at the above location at the same time as the athlete they are accompanying in order to receive their accreditation.

Companions do not receive free festival access and must purchase a ticket to first enter the event.
