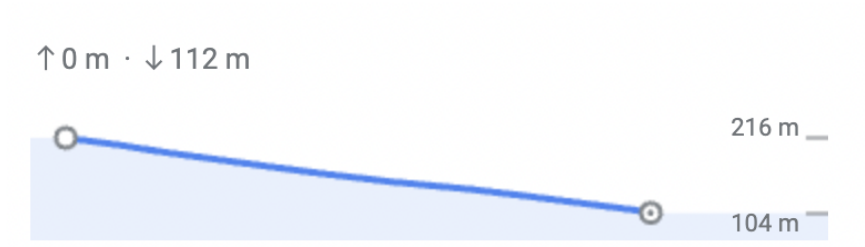
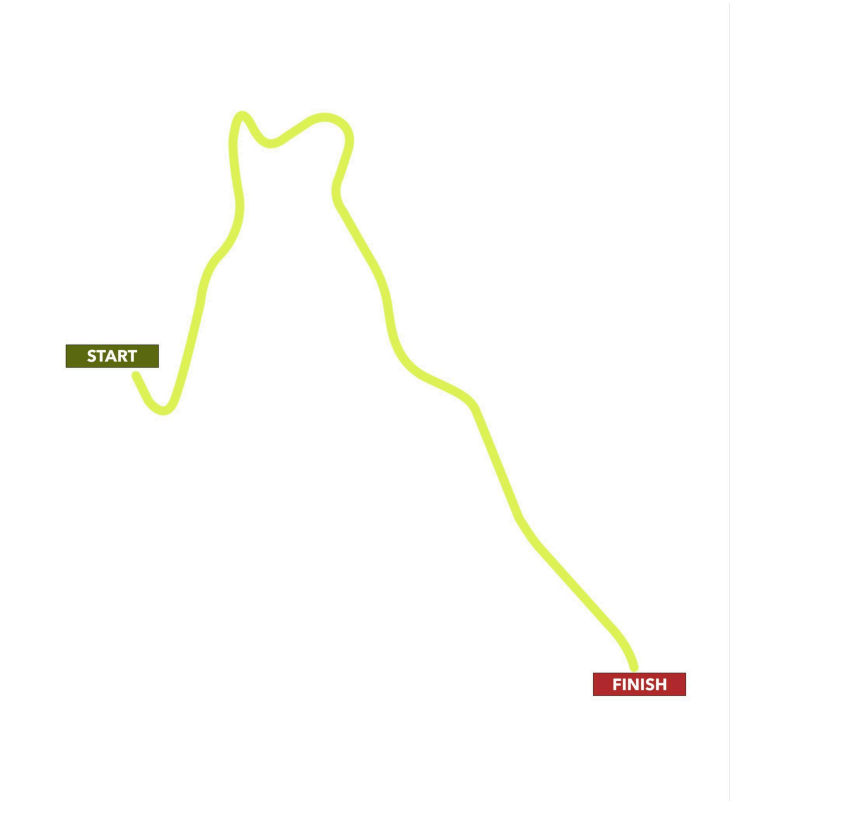

DOWNHILL WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS 2024

World Skate is proud to announce the Downhill Skateboarding and Street Luge World Championships 2024 to be held in Tortoreto, in Abruzzo region, Italy. This will be the fourth World Skate-sanctioned Championships of Downhill Skateboarding and Street Luge.

PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE

Provisional schedule for Downhill Skateboarding & Street Luge:

September 17th - Official training, Technical Meeting

September 18th - Official training

September 19th - Official training

September 20th - Time trials

September 21st - Race and Finals

Subject to change. The schedule will be defined upon registration closure.

COMPETITION FORMAT

For both Downhill Skateboarding & Street Luge:

- Time Trials (Men and Women)
- World Championships race (*4-person heats* for both men and women)

Both time trials and World Championship races will be awarded with medals.

COUNTRY QUOTAS

Athletes:

Maximum 8 athletes per gender per country are allowed to participate. This is intended as the total number of athletes competing for Downhill Skateboarding & Street Luge disciplines altogether.

Within the men's team, a maximum of 6 can be from a single discipline.

Within the women's team, a maximum of 6 can be from a single discipline.

It is not possible for an athlete to register in both disciplines.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to downhill.skateboarding@worldskate.org within **1st of August 2024**.

Please note that a wild card athlete is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited only to the cases below:

- Lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the athlete's country of origin.
- Host country citizenship.
- Event organizer Wildcards.

The National Federations (NFs) are entitled to register a specific number of National Team Officials (NTOs), listed above. NFs with a large number of competing athletes may apply for additional NTO quotas, pending approval by World Skate.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.

PRE-SEEDED ATHLETES

The top 5 athletes in each discipline and gender from the final results of World Skate Games Italy will be *pre-seeded* for the *next* World Skate event.

Pre-seeded riders will:

- **not** count against their country's rider quota;
- be eligible for the 2nd run of time trial without needing to do a 1st run in the time trial. Their positions in the 2nd run will be in addition to those riders eligible based on times in the 1st run.
