WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP:

- Two groups A and B, with four teams in each group:
 - 1st phase: all against all (round-robin)
 - 2nd phase: crossovers, semi-finals and final
 - Final classification: from 1st to 8th

The last two classified in each group, A and B, in the 1st Phase, are relegated to the Intercontinental Champ. in the 2nd Phase, as first in the group, playing the 2nd phase in the Intercontinental Champ.

The last two classified in the final classification, 7th and 8th, are relegated to Intercontinental Champ. for the next championship.

INTERCONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP:

- Two groups C and D, with four teams in each group:
 - 1st phase: all against all (round-robin)
 - 2nd phase: crossovers, semi-finals and final
 - Final classification: from 1st to 8th

The first two in the final classification, 1st and 2nd, are promoted to World Champ. for the next championship.

The last two in the final classification, 7th and 8th, are relegated to Challenger Champ. for the next championship.

CHALLENGER CHAMPIONSHIP

- TWO GROUPS E and F, with one group of six teams and one group of five teams:
 - o 1st phase: all against all (round-robin)
 - o 2nd phase: 1° C - 1° D; 2° C - 2° D; ...
 - o Final classification: from 1st to 11th

The first two classified in the final classification, 1st and 2nd, are promoted to Intercontinental Champ. for the next championship.

The team classified in 6th position in the group six, will occupy 11th place in the final group classification and 27th at the end of the entire competition.
