According to the FIRS Statutes, Rules for the World Championships Art.44, having shared with the Responsible of the Master Category, Mr Sergio Landi, the possibility of organizing the 2016 World Master Speed Skating Championships on the occasion of the 2016 World Speed Skating Championships in Nanjing, the FIRS is pleased to invite all the participants to send their entries to:

The expenses of travel, board and lodging will be up to each participant.

#### ENTRY FEES

Each participating skater will pay the following entry fees: 40 USD for each skater that will register no later than June 30, 2016 60 USD for each skater that will register no later than June 15, 2016 80 USD for each skater that will register the same day of the Marathon.

### CATEGORIES

A skater can compete in Master races when he is more than thirty-five (35) years old at December 31, 2016. The age for Master categories are:

- Under 40 (36 to 39) (Year of birth 1980 1977)
- Under 50 (40 to 49) (Year of birth 1976 1967)
- Under 60 (50 to 59) (Year of birth 1966 1957)
- Under 70 (60 to 69) (Year of birth 1956-1947)
- Over 70 (Year of birth 1946 and older)

### DISTANCES

Marathon km 42,195

The time limit to finish the race is fixed at 1.45 hours.

The race program will be the same for men and women, master categories.

The race will start at 7.30 for the all the men categories and at 7.35 for the women categories.

#### MARATHON ROUTE

The marathon will take place on Jiang Dong Middle Road (one lap about 5 km) and will start on the Easting Square of Olympic Sports Center.

#### **BIB & CHIP**

The delivery of bib and chip will be held on Saturday September 17 from 20:00 to 21:00 at the:

Han Yue Lou Hotel, Nanjing No. 235 Middle Jiangdong Road Jianye District Nanjing City Jiangsu Province, 210019, P.R. China

The chip will be delivered upon presentation of an identity document. The ID will be returned at the end of the race. The penalty for the loss of the chip is 150 USD

#### MEDICAL CERTIFICATE

Upon delivery of the numbers it is compulsory present a medical certificate of athletic eligibility.



Those who do not submit the aforementioned certificate, will not be allowed to participate in the Marathon.

All the participants will be required to sign a self-certification declaring, under their own responsibility, to be in possession of a medical certificate attesting the athletic eligibility.

#### WHEEL DIAMETER

According to the Bulletin No 01 of January 18, 2016, is allowed the use of the wheels up to a maximum size of 125 mm.

#### **ANTI-DOPING CONTROL**

The anti doping control will be carried out according to FIRS Medical Regulations and WADA Rules.

#### CONTROL OF FEMALE SEX

No female sex certificate is required. Nevertheless, in conformity with IOC guidelines, FIRS is entitled to conduct some tests on specific occasions. This would mean laboratory tests could be done if there is a suspicion.

#### **RULES**

The FIRS Speed Technical Committee Regulations, 2015/2016 edition and FIRS Rules will be valid for these Championships.
