#### NON OFFICIAL TRAINING SESSIONS TRACK RENTAL

Participants arriving before September 10th are allowed to rent the track for extra official training. To book such training sessions, they can contact Ms. Yuna Yuan by sending a message to this email address: speedskatingwcbdh@163.com

Only training sessions applied for before September 10th require payment, which is managed by the organizing committee. The pre-World Speed Skating Championships training fee is \$100 USD per hour.

A training session and its duration can be applied for by one team, allowing them to train alongside up to two other teams (no more than three teams per session, with a total number of participants not exceeding 50).

#### **OVERSEAS SPECTATORS**

Regarding tickets for overseas spectators, the LOC is not handling ticket sales. Each participant National Federation is asked to report how many tickets they need to speedskatingwcbdh@163.com They will issue one all-access pass per the number they request. This pass will grant entry to the venue to watch the competition throughout the event. This information must be provided no later than September 5th.



#### REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

All information regarding registration dates and modality is included in **Bulletin #02**.

The registration process is currently open through the <u>World Skate Infinity</u> platform and will remain available until <u>September 1st</u>, <u>2025 (23:59 CET)</u>.

#### **Wild Card Requests:**

Athletes otherwise not eligible to compete may be granted a Wild Card by World Skate.

Please note that a Wild Card is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to the cases provided for in the "World Skate By-Laws".

A Wild Card may be granted in case of lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.

In the case of a Country with a recognized NGB that does not include Speed in its activities, the athletes shall mandatorily contact the relevant NGB for approval and clearance to compete for their respective Countries and under their own Anthem and Flag. Should the mentioned Governing Body not answer within 15 days, World Skate might allow the athlete concerned to compete under his/her Country Anthem and Flag.

#### JUDGES EXAMINATION SESSION REMINDER

During the World Championships (on September 16th) an official Examination Session will be held for the national judges candidates to become International Judges (Track or Secretary categories). As per the rules, such candidates must possess a written authorisation letter from their National Federation. The due date for the registration is August 31st. They can apply by sending their information in the document on the following Form LINK.

After verification, each candidate will receive the fee payment details by email.

#### **ACCOMODATION AND MEALS**

Official hotel availability is limited, so please book as soon as possible. The deadline is August 31st.

Athletes, and delegations will have meals at their respective hotels. Meal vouchers will be issued to each person upon check-in. Please note that it is important to keep your vouchers safe; otherwise, you will need to purchase additional vouchers.

#### TRANSPORTATION

LOC will provide airport transfers to and from the official hotel based on the flight schedules of the WSK family and ITO.

#### Airport transfer costs will be borne by each delegation.

The organizing committee will provide rental car services, and delegations that require a bus must provide their arrival (and departure) flight information. <u>Due date: August 31st.</u>

The bus transfer service will cover the following routes: Beijing Capital International Airport - Beidaihe and Tianjin Binhai International Airport - Beidaihe.

# **VISA INVITATION LETTER REMINDER**

It is recommended to contact the Chinese Embassy or Consultant in your country or region and be informed on the official specific polici11es for your particular case. Take into account that China has implemented a unilateral visa-free policy and the visa-free policy applies to participants from a few more countries willing to participate in the event.

Note that invitation letters will be issued only after completing the registration process to the event on the World Skate Infinity Platform. No exceptions will be made. It is vital to check the official websites of the Chinese embassies and consulates in your country for visa policy in advance, to see your particular case.

#### **MEDICAL SERVICE**

The Beidaihe District in Qinhuangdao City has advanced medical measures and can provide effective medical support for the competition. There are four public hospitals in Beidaihe



District, which offer medical rescue services during the competition. There are always at least 2 ambulances on standby at the competition venue, and professional medical personnel have set up medical stations at multiple points on the field to provide treatment for athletes.

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

In the event that a competition or event is postponed or canceled due to circumstances beyond the control of World Skate, World Skate will not be held liable for any financial losses incurred by participants.

Participants are strongly encouraged to obtain appropriate insurance coverage to protect themselves against potential losses.

# ANTI-DOPING INFORMATION REMINDER

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Organizations and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA ADEL</u> <u>platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
