We are pleased to deliver updated information about The World Games 2025, in the INLINE HOCKEY discipline (Senior Men category) to be held in the city of Chengdu - People's Republic of China, from 7 to 11 August.

*All the fifteen (15) participants per Team need to complete the WADA's Anti-Doping Education and learning course in order to receive their TWG accreditation. Certificates will count as valid if taken from 1 August 2023 onwards.

IWGA - WORLD SKATE COMMITMENT

As per the Official IWGA Commitment for Speed Skating, the Organization will provide the one hundred and twelve (112) Athletes and the eight (8) Team Officials Coaches quota with free accommodation in twin rooms, catering and local transport.

INLINE HOCKEY EXTRA TEAM OFFICIALS

As a reminder, Extra Team Officials are Assistant Coach, Equipment Staff, Medical Staff or Team Manager, coming with the country Team (14 athletes and one (1) Coach). The Extra Team Officials are to cover their *Accreditation Packages against Fee per Night/Day (option 1)*. The payment modalities will soon be informed by the TWG Participant Services division. You can see the details by clicking <u>HERE</u>.

Each country must contact the World Skate Sports Department to coordinate the details of their participation regarding accommodation and dates confirmation.

The designated accommodation for the World Skate three sports will be the Athlete's Village zone B. In case the Village is full and therefore it would not be possible to stay there, the LOC will propose a hotel nearby.

INVITATION & VISA APPLICATION LETTER ISSUANCE

Most of the invitation letters and visa application letters have already been sent to the participants to the email address they provided on the Infinity platform. Only a few are still being processed and will shortly be sent. In the case a participant has not yet received it, please let us know to <u>sportsdepartment@worldskate.org</u>

It is highly recommended to consult your local Chinese Consulate to solve any question and to print the letter before traveling, to make sure the participants can show it to the immigration authorities, in case they are required to. This could happen even if you are not supposed to possess a Chinese visa.

PARTICIPANTS TRAVEL INFORMATION

The TWG Participants Services division will contact each person to find out their travel details (flights / trains) to coordinate the local transport.

CONSENT AND DATA PRIVACY POLICY APPROVAL

Consent Forms and Data Privacy Policy Approval Form will directly be shared with the participants so that they can proceed to send their consent through a platform. This process will be carried out before July 31st 2025.

INSURANCE <u>REMINDER</u>

All participants, including athletes and officials representing your federation, must possess a valid private health and repatriation insurance in accordance with the Rules of The World Games.

This insurance must mandatorily cover the following:

- Accidental medical treatment, sudden illness, and hospitalization allowance.
- Repatriation costs in emergencies requiring a return to your place of departure.

Participants are required to purchase the adequate insurance prior to their departure and provide a valid insurance certificate upon arrival in Chengdu as part of the accreditation process.

Important:



Any participant failing to present their insurance certificate or not meeting the minimum required coverage will not be allowed to participate in The World Games 2025.

World Skate, the Chengdu ExCo and IWGA will not be held liable for any risks, denial, costs or loss arising from a lack of adequate insurance.

We kindly request all National Federations to ensure compliance with these requirements and communicate this information to your athletes and officials at the earliest opportunity.

ANTIDOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection process and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the IWGA's Antidoping Rules, the WADA Code and the International Standards for Testing and Investigation.

According to IWGA's Anti-Doping Rules, participating athletes, medical personnel and one team official (coach) in team sports are required to complete WADA's Anti-Doping Education and Learning (ADEL) course or other WADA approved courses in order to receive their accreditations and participate in The World Games. All concerned participants must upload their certificate to their Infinity profile, no later than July 25th.

The following courses are recommended by WADA:

- For athletes: ADEL for International Level Athletes (ILA) (25 languages) or ADEL for Talented Athletes (TA) Competed at Major Events (Youth athletes, English, French, Spanish)
- For Coaches: ADEL for Coaches of High-Performance athletes (12 languages)
- For Medical Professionals: ADEL for Medical Professionals at Major Games (English, French, Spanish, Bulgarian, Croatian, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Ukrainian)

Only ADEL certificates are valid, no certificates issued by NADOs or any other bodies other than WADA will be valid. Certificates will count as valid if taken from 1 August 2023 onwards. If the ADEL certificate is from before 1 August 2023, participants can take the refresher course and must share both, their original certificate and the refresher certificate taken after 1 August 2023.
