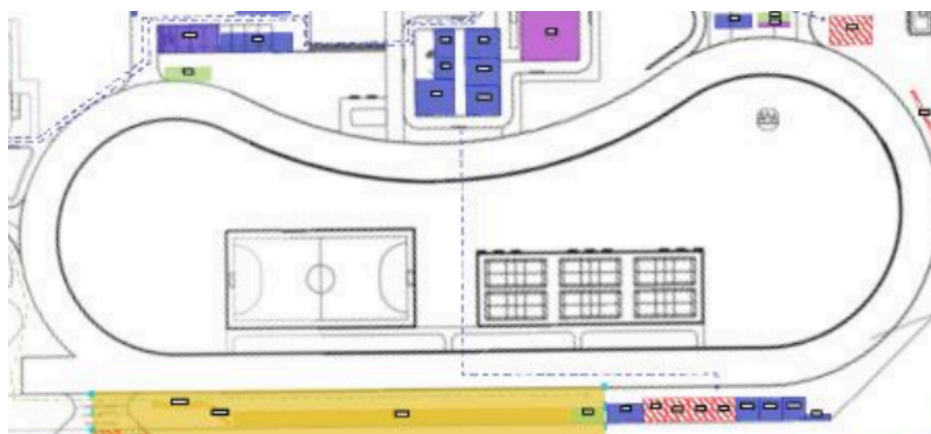
## TECHNICAL MEETING

## INVITATION & VISA APPLICATION LETTER ISSUANCE

Most of the invitation letters and visa application letters have already been sent to the participants to the email address they provided on the Infinity platform. Only a few are still being processed and will shortly be sent. In the case a participant has not yet received it, please let us know to [sportsdepartment@worldskate.org](mailto:sportsdepartment@worldskate.org)

It is highly recommended to consult your local Chinese Consulate to solve any question and to print the letter before traveling, to make sure the participants can show it to the immigration authorities, in case they are required to. This could happen even if you are not supposed to possess a Chinese visa.

## IWGA - WORLD SKATE COMMITMENT

As per the Official IWGA Commitment for Speed Skating, the Organization will provide the sixty (60) Athletes quota with free accommodation in twin rooms, catering and local transport.

## SPEED SKATING EXTRA TEAM OFFICIALS

Extra Team Officials are Coaches, Medical staff, Team manager, Staff. Each country must contact the World Skate Sports Department to coordinate the details of their participation regarding accommodation and dates confirmation.

The designated accommodation for the World Skate three sports will be the Athlete's Village zone B. In case the Village is full and therefore it would not be possible to stay there, the LOC will propose a hotel nearby.

The Accreditation package will be Option 1, you can see the details by clicking [HERE](#). In the following stage, the Local Organising Committee (LOC) will announce the payment methods.

## CONSENT AND DATA PRIVACY POLICY APPROVAL

Consent Forms and Data Privacy Policy Approval Form will directly be shared with the

participants so that they can proceed to upload it duly signed through a platform. This process will be carried out before July 31st 2025.

## **INSURANCE REMINDER**

All participants, including athletes and officials representing your federation, must possess a valid private health and repatriation insurance in accordance with the Rules of The World Games.

This insurance must mandatorily cover the following:

- Accidental medical treatment, sudden illness, and hospitalization allowance.
- Repatriation costs in emergencies requiring a return to your place of departure.

Participants are required to purchase the adequate insurance prior to their departure and provide a valid insurance certificate upon arrival in Chengdu as part of the accreditation process.

**Important:**

Any participant failing to present their insurance certificate or not meeting the minimum required coverage will not be allowed to participate in The World Games 2025.

World Skate, the Chengdu ExCo and IWGA will not be held liable for any risks, denial, costs or loss arising from a lack of adequate insurance.

We kindly request all National Federations to ensure compliance with these requirements, communicate this information to your athletes and officials at the earliest opportunity and inform World Skate about the compliance of this requisite.

## **ANTIDOPING**

The doping controls, the sample collection process and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the IWGA's Antidoping Rules, the WADA Code and the International Standards for Testing and Investigation.

According to IWGA's Anti-Doping Rules, participating athletes, medical personnel and one team official (coach) in team sports are required to complete WADA's Anti-Doping Education and Learning (ADEL) course or other WADA approved courses in order to receive their accreditations and participate in The World Games. All concerned participants must upload their certificate to their Infinity profile, no later than July 25th.

The following courses are recommended by WADA:

- For athletes: ADEL for International Level Athletes (ILA) (25 languages) or ADEL for Talented Athletes (TA) Competed at Major Events (Youth athletes, English, French, Spanish)
- For Coaches: ADEL for Coaches of High-Performance athletes (12 languages)
- For Medical Professionals: ADEL for Medical Professionals at Major Games (English, French, Spanish, Bulgarian, Croatian, Portuguese, Romanian, Russian, Ukrainian)


