We are delighted to announce that the **World Skateboarding Tour 2025** for Street will begin in the city of **Rome, Italy**.

This event will be a **Pro Tour** event, and the results will contribute ranking points toward the World Skateboarding Ranking.

The competition venue and the skatepark will undergo scheduled infrastructure set-up works starting May 12th.

We recommend you check <u>https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home/en</u>, to determine whether a VISA is required for your travel to Italy. The website also provides specific information about the visa issuing authority, taking into account various parameters. Please be sure to read all the information carefully.

IF YOU REQUIRE A VISA

Should you require a VISA, please follow the instructions below:

- 1. Fill out <u>Annex 1</u> with all the necessary information
- 2. Email the filled form to the email addresses listed at the bottom of this section
- 3. A protocol number will be issued by the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI)
- 4. Provide the protocol number to your local consulate or embassy when requesting a VISA for the process to be expedited

Please note that it can be processed only after completing the registration on the World Skate Sports Entry Platform "Infinity", and there will be no exceptions. For the details of registration, please refer to the "Registration" section.

We recommend initiating inquiries with your local embassies/consulates for visa requests and scheduling visa appointments to prevent bureaucratic delays.

IF YOU DO NOT REQUIRE A VISA

Should you NOT require a VISA, but need an invitation letter, please fill the <u>Annex 1</u> and send to the email addresses listed below. An invitation letter will be sent to you.

COUNTRY QUOTA

Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register **3** athletes per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the Extra Quota skaters do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations do not need to register pre-seeded and extra quota skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Wild Card Requests:

Athletes otherwise not eligible to compete may be granted a Wild Card by World Skate.

Please note that a Wild Card is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to the cases provided for in the "<u>World Skate By-Laws</u>".

A Wild Card may be granted in case of lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.

In the case of a Country with a recognized NGB that does not include skateboarding in its activities, the athletes shall mandatorily contact the relevant NGB for approval and clearance to compete for their respective Countries and under their own Anthem and Flag. Should the mentioned Governing Body not answer within 15 days, World Skate might allow the athlete concerned to compete under his/her Country Anthem and Flag.

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.



EXTRA QUOTA FOR ROME STREET 2025

The table in the next page shows the top 30 athletes in the World Skateboarding Ranking (WSR) as of April 9, 2025. It lists the individuals whom the respective NF are eligible to register as Extra Quota athletes, up to the top six ranked competitors of the country.

The ones <u>marked with a star[O]</u> are those currently holding the right to become Pre-seeded, as long as the National Federation registers and confirms their participation before the deadline. The deadline for confirmation is <u>May 15th, 2025.</u>

The ones <u>marked with an asterisk[*]</u> are those that are ranked 7th or lower within their own country, but still have the right to take an Extra Quota in case there is any withdrawal from their respective country and gender.

If a Pre-seeded athlete withdraws before the registration deadline, the next highest-ranked skater in the WSR will be pre-seeded. In such a case, we will contact the relevant NF directly.

The Pre-seeded athletes will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into the next competition phase.

For the details of Pre-seeded athletes, please refer to the <u>Competition Season Criteria</u> <u>2025</u> released on April 3, 2025.

<u>Please note that all participants, including pre-seeded competitors, are required to pay the entry fee.</u>

All skaters must complete the event check-in <u>no later than **2 days before**</u> the first day of the competition. This deadline <u>also applies to skaters pre seeded in the Quarterfinals</u>.

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform, and will be open <u>from April 22nd, 2025 at 00.00am (CET) to May 15th, 2025 at 11.59pm</u> (CET).

World Skate Infinity is available on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store (iOS)</u>.

Single Users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up in the App or desktop version and create a profile (if they have not done so already), with all the required data and information, as well as uploading the mandatory documents: passport copy, profile picture (headshot), AD Training Course Certificate.

Once they have completed creating their profile on Infinity, they are eligible to be registered for the event by their National Federation of belonging.

Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer. Each National Federation must confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version only) by the registration deadline. <u>Please do not register Pre-Seeded and Extra Quota Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within</u> <u>your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their</u> <u>participation.</u>



Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as "Neutral athletes" following the "<u>Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian</u> <u>Athletes</u>".

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking <u>here</u>.

Only one legal guardian or parent per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is May 8th, 2025.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

<u>Please note</u> that providing your data and Passport in Infinity as a verification process for minor skaters' profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

After completing the Form above, parents and legal guardians (if they haven't done it yet) are required to sign up and create a profile on Infinity as explained in the previous section. Parents and legal guardians must select "Other" as a category when required during the registration process in Infinity.



ENTRY FEE

<u>ALL participating athletes</u> for the event will pay the following fee: **200 USD**. Payments will be processed through Infinity by credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Deadline of the Entry Fee: May 19th, 2025

Note: The athletes that have not completed the payment will not be considered "Registered", and therefore they will not be listed in practice heats nor the competition heats.



ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Organizations and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the <u>WADA</u> <u>ADEL platform</u> and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the <u>WADA ADEL platform</u> is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
