# **OPEN COMPETITION - LAST FINALIST CHOICE**

Prior to the final, in the same venue, a 'Last Chance' event will take place, offering



skaters one final opportunity to qualify for the final. In this event, skaters will perform only the long program or free dance, and the winner will earn a spot in the final. All skaters can participate except those already selected for the final.

Registration Fee is the same as for the other Series events and the Final. The skater winning "The Last Chance" will not pay a registration fee to participate in the final.

# LAST CHANCE

- The Last Chance event will be **open** to all skaters/couples in the categories of Cadet, Youth, Junior and Senior.
- Coaches who will participate only in the Last Chance and not in the Final must always be registered through the LOC.
- Registration is through LOC at the email: <a href="mailto:info@rollergp.org">info@rollergp.org</a>.
- Whenever possible, an equal number of skaters from each country will be permitted.
- Skaters will compete only with Long Program or Free Dance.
- The winner will advance to the final.
- This competition will not give ranking points to the skaters.

The skating order for Junior and Senior skaters will be in reverse order of their placement in the World Skate Ranking as of the competition date.



Please note that, although the athletes participating in the Last Chance event will not be registered directly through the <u>World Skate Infinity platform</u>, they are still required to have a complete profile, including a valid passport, a valid anti-doping certificate and a passport-style profile photo.

Registration dates (The Last Chance only): 28<sup>th</sup>April - 30<sup>th</sup> May

# **PREQUALIFIED ATHLETES**

Skaters who have participated in previous stages of the International Series and qualified for the final **will be registered by World Skate** in the Infinity platform.

Athletes will be registered using the competition files submitted for the last AIS event in which they participated. To update or change these documents, they must contact <a href="mailto:artistic@worldskate.org">artistic@worldskate.org</a>.

Please note that competition files can be updated within 5 days prior to the first day of the event.

Each National Federation must confirm (or decline) the participation of its Pre-qualified Athletes ("Pre-seeded" athletes in the system) within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version only) by the registration deadline.

They can do that from the same page used to register athletes to the event by clicking on "confirm" or "decline" below the name of each athlete.

# **WILD CARDS**

If a Continent (Europe, Africa, America, Asia, Oceania) does not have at least one representative in the top eight (8) places for any Junior or Senior event, a Wildcard entry to the final will be granted to one top ranked skater in that event. Wildcards will be offered by World Skate ATC in consultation with the continent involved.

Once the Wild card has been approved by the Artistic Skating Technical Commission, the relevant National Federation will receive an e-mail by <a href="mailto:platform@worldskate.org">platform@worldskate.org</a> with further information about the competition files to be provided. The registration will then



be processed by World Skate. Once the registration will be completed, the payment option will be made available on the platform.

# **SHOW AND PRECISION**

During the week competitions of Precision Junior and Senior, Quartet Senior, Small and Large Show will take place.

- The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform.
- Max 1 coaches per team.
- This competition will not give ranking points to the skaters.

World Skate Infinity is available both on <u>desktop</u> (browser) and App Version on <u>Play Store</u> (Android) and <u>App Store</u> (iOS).

All single users (Athletes, National Team Members) must <u>individually</u> sign up on the platform—either through the app or desktop—and create a personal profile (if not already done). The profile must include all required personal information and the upload of the following mandatory documents:

- Copy of a valid passport
- A recent headshot/profile picture (passport-style with white background)
- Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate

Once the profile has been successfully created, they become eligible to be <u>registered for the event by their respective National Federation</u>.

# **Application for Neutral Athletes:**

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as "Neutral athletes" following the "Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes".



# **REGISTRATION FEE**

Prequalified athletes: 95,00 USD per discipline

Show and Precision: 50,00 USD per skater per discipline

Official Coaches: 60,00 USD each

Extra Officials: 100,00 USD each

Registration fees must be paid through Infinity, and can be completed via credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Please note: if paying by bank transfer, you must <u>upload the proof of payment in Infinity</u>. Without this, the payment cannot be confirmed.

# THE FINAL

Up to 8 ladies and 8 men from the Cadet, Youth, Junior, and Senior categories (excluding Wild Cards and Last Chance Finalists) will qualify for the final. The highest-ranked skater from each nation based on their highest overall score from the qualifying rounds, will be selected first. If spots remain after this initial selection, the next highest-ranked skaters from each nation will be considered, starting with the highest-ranked skater overall, until all 8 spots are filled. If a continent has no representation in the final, a Wild Card will be awarded to the highest-ranked skater from that continent.

#### **AWARDS**

Senior Podiums will be awarded with Prize Money from World Skate:

1<sup>st</sup> 3000 USD 2<sup>nd</sup> 2000 USD 3<sup>rd</sup> 1000 USD

#### **MISCELLANEOUS**

The event will feature various other awards and activities for all participating skaters. Some of these awards may be judged by Non-Skating Family judges to provide an independent perspective on the skaters' performances.



Finalists will perform in the event's final event. Further details will be announced at a later date.

# **TRAININGS**

The rink will be available for non-official training from 3 days before the start of the event. Email to contact to book the training is: info@rollergp.org.

The rink will also be available for hire for training at any time when there are no competitions taking place.

#### **ANTIDOPING**

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024 and 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the WADA ADEL platform and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the WADA ADEL platform is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.
