Dear Sir/Madam,

As announced in [Bulletin#01](#), the Roller Freestyle World Championships will be held in Sakai, Ibaraki prefecture, Japan.

The Park World Championships will take place 21st - 26th November 2025 and the Street World Championships will take place 21st - 27th November 2025.

In the Park discipline, we will be hosting Men's and Women's categories. In the Street discipline, we will be hosting Men's, Women's, Junior Men's and Junior Women's categories.

## VENUE LOCATION

The event will be hosted in the town of Sakai, in the Ibaraki prefecture, near Tokyo. The exact location can be found [here](#).

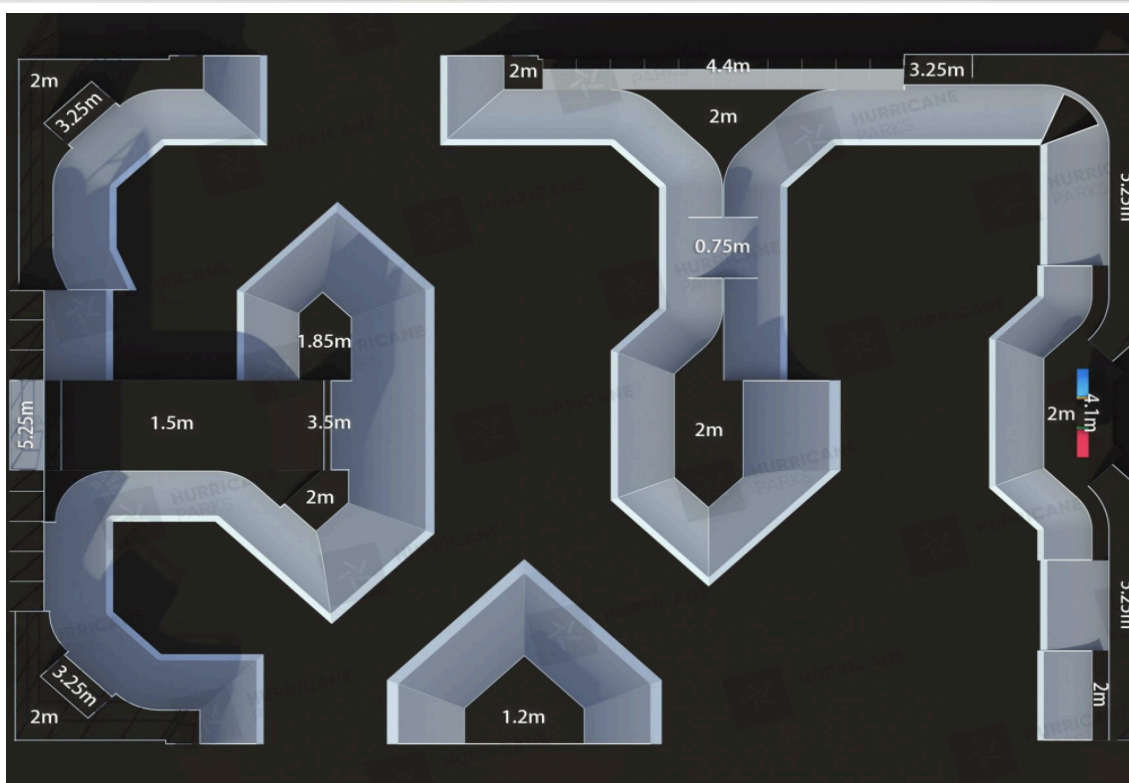
Sakai is located 52 miles from Tokyo Narita airport (NRT) and 57 miles from Tokyo Haneda airport (HND). Travel times are 60-90 minutes by car.

From [Tokyo Central Station](#), a highway bus service is available to [Sakaimachi Kosoku Bus Terminal](#), with a journey time of 80-90 minutes. The bus terminal is 350m from the competition venue.

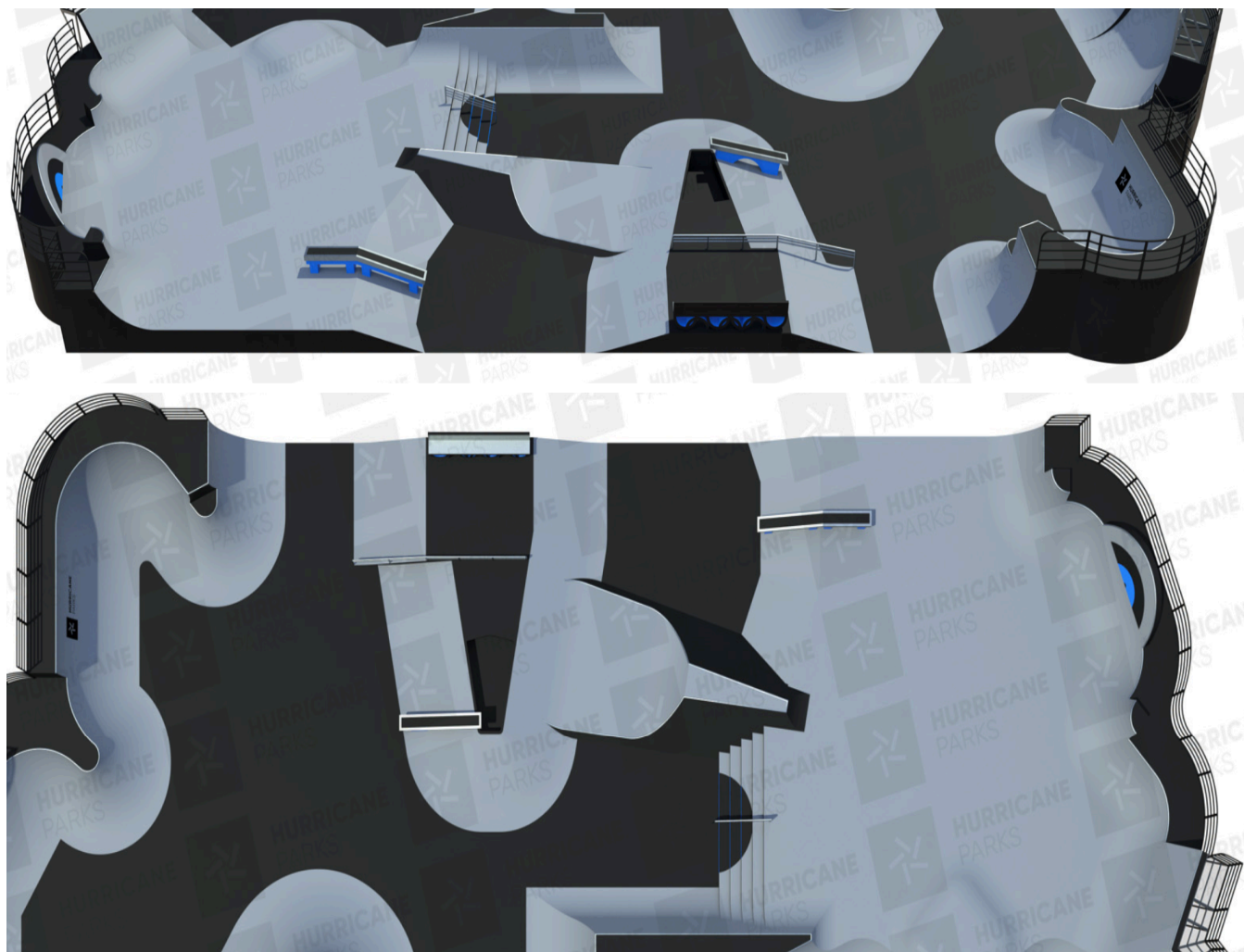

## 2025 RULEBOOK

The [2025 Rulebook](#) contains several key changes that athletes and national federations should familiarise themselves with. Some of these changes include new competition formats, suggested round structures, and updates to athlete safety requirements.

## REGISTRATION DATES & MODALITY

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform and will be open during the following period:

**August 27th, 2025 (00:00, CET) - October 29th, 2025 (23:59, CET).**

World Skate Infinity is available both on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

All single users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up on the platform either through the app or desktop and create a personal profile (if not already done). The profile must include all required personal information and the upload of the following mandatory documents:

- Copy of a valid passport
- A recent headshot/profile picture (passport-style with white background)
- Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate

Once the profile has been successfully created, they become eligible to be registered for the event by their respective National Federation.

### **Application for Neutral Athletes:**

Russian and Belarusian athletes can participate only as “Neutral athletes” following the “[Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes](#)”.

Application for Neutral Athletes deadline: **October 15th, 2025.**

## COUNTRY QUOTA & PRE-SEEDED RIDERS

Information regarding country quota, pre-seeded athletes, and the World Rankings can be found in [Bulletin#01](#).

**Please do not register Pre-Seeded athletes within your Country Quota. These athletes will be registered directly by World Skate. You will only need to confirm or decline their participation by October 29th.**

### **Wild Card Requests:**

Athletes otherwise not eligible to compete may be granted a Wild Card by World Skate.

Please note that a Wild Card is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to the cases provided for in the "[World Skate By-Laws](#)".

A Wild Card may be granted in case of lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.

In the case of a Country with a recognized NGB that does not include Roller Freestyle in its activities, the athletes shall mandatorily contact the relevant NGB for approval and clearance to compete for their respective Countries and under their own Anthem and Flag. Should the mentioned Governing Body not answer within 15 days, World Skate might allow the athlete concerned to compete under his/her Country Anthem and Flag.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to [platform@worldskate.org](mailto:platform@worldskate.org) within **October 22nd, 2025**.

### **Pre-Seeded Athletes:**

The top 3 athletes from each of the 2024 World Championships, given that they are still eligible to compete in the relevant category, are pre-seeded into the competition.

Pre-seeded athletes do not count against the country quota and do not pay a registration fee for the relevant discipline they are seeded into.

Pre-seeded riders enter the competition at the first round. These athletes will be automatically registered for the event and must not register via their National Federation.



## ENTRY FEE

Men's & Women's: **100 USD** per discipline

Junior Men & Junior Women: **50 USD** per discipline

**Registration fees** must be paid through Infinity, and can be completed via credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Please note: if paying by bank transfer, you must upload the proof of payment in Infinity. Without this, the payment cannot be confirmed.

Entry Fee payment deadline: **November 5th, 2025**.

Note: The athletes that have not completed the payment will not be considered "Registered", and therefore they will not be listed in practice heats nor the competition heats.

Pre-seeded athletes do not pay a fee for the specific discipline that they are pre-seeded in.

## MINORS' PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minors' (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking [here](#).

Only **one legal guardian or parent** per minor athlete can be registered.

Registration deadline is **October 29th, 2025**.

The legal guardian/parent is expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

**Please note** that providing your data and Passport in Infinity as a verification process for a minor athlete's profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

After completing the Form above, parents and legal guardians (if they haven't done it yet) are required to sign up and create a profile on [Infinity](#) as explained in the previous section. Parents and legal guardians must select "Other" as a category when required during the registration process in Infinity.





## ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager and/or Delegate.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration Platform (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Agencies and/or World Skate during 2023, 2024, 2025 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.

## PRIZE MONEY

The total prize purse for the Park and Street World Championships is \$30,000 shared equally between Men's and Women's categories and both disciplines. There is no prize money for Junior categories. The \$7,500 prize pool for each competition will be broken down as below:

- 1st: \$3,500
- 2nd: \$2,000
- 3rd: \$1,000
- 4th: \$600
- 5th: \$400

We will publish information regarding the list of official hotels in an upcoming bulletin. This will include recommended accommodation, transport details, support services during the event, and visa information.


