Women's Park: Semi-final -> Final (10) Junior Park: Semi-final -> Final (10)

Street Format

Qualification & Semi-final rounds: 2x 45-second runs, best run counts, max score 100

All Finals: 2/3/3 (full details in the Rulebook)

Men's Street: Qualification -> Semi-final (20) -> Final (10)

Women's Street: Semi-final -> Final (10) Junior Street: Semi-final -> Final (10)

ANTI-DOPING WORKSHOP AND EDUCATIONAL BOOTH

On November 21, two sessions of an Anti-Doping Workshop will be conducted by an Ambassador from the International Testing Agency (ITA), in collaboration with World Skate.

First session: 11:00 AMSecond session: 3:00 PM

Participation in the workshop is highly recommended for all athletes and athlete support personnel. The sessions will provide practical information and guidance on anti-doping rules, responsibilities, and best practices.

On November 22, an educational booth will be available on-site to provide further information, answer questions, and facilitate direct conversations with athletes and their support teams.

ON-SITE PARKING FOR ACCREDITED PERSONNEL

Parking is available for National Federations and athletes arriving at the venue by car. A VAPP (Vehicle Access and Parking Permit) must be obtained in advance from the Local Organising Committee by emailing sakai-urbansportspark@abcplanning.jp with the following information:

- National Federation
- Applicant name and NF role
- Number of vehicle permits required

The LOC will register the vehicle(s) to the NF and provide the VAPP(s). Each VAPP must be printed in A4 size and presented at the venue when parking.
