

2026 China Roller Skating Marathon Open

- Shanghai Station Regulations

I. Competition Date and Location

(A) Date: March 29, 2026

(B) Location: Jinniu Square, Bund, Huangpu District, Shanghai (Starting Point)

II. Participants

Professional roller skating athletes and enthusiasts from around the world.

III. Competition Events and Age Groups

(A) Competition Events

1. Full Marathon: 42.195 KM, divided by male/female;
2. Half Marathon: 21 KM, divided by male/female;
3. 10km Marathon: 10 KM;

(B) Age Groups

1. Full Marathon Group: Born on or before December 31, 2011.
2. Half Marathon Group A: Born on or before December 31, 2011.
3. Half Marathon Group B: Born between January 1, 2012, and December 31, 2016.
4. 10km Marathon: Born on or before December 31, 2018 and 10km race with a minimum of 30 minutes (training or competition results are acceptable)

Note: Each athlete can only register for one group to compete.

IV. Participation Guidelines

(A) Each participating team may register 1 team leader and 1 coach, with no limit on the number of athletes. If the number of athletes aged under 15 in the

team exceeds 5, an additional coach may be assigned for every 5 athletes in that age range (if there are fewer than 5, it will be counted as 5), based on the grade of the coach's qualification certificate.

(B) Athletes aged 16 and above may register as individuals, while athletes aged under 15 must register as a team.

(C) This competition will be held concurrently with the 2026 world Skate Marathon Tour (Shanghai Stage). Each athlete can only register for one event; if there is duplicate registration, the registrations for the Marathon Open will be canceled.

(D) Athletes under the age of 16 must have a guardian's signature when registering and must be accompanied by a guardian during the competition.

(E) Participants must wear appropriate sportswear and fix their bib numbers as required. No Non-competition items (such as masks, flags, banners, cosplay items, etc.) are permitted. Violators will be disqualified.

(F) Requirements for roller skates: speed skating skates or speed skating training skates, with wheel diameter between 90mm and 125mm, and the skate blade length not exceeding 50cm.

(G) Athletes must collect the clothing bags issued by the organizing committee before the competition to store personal belongings. After the race, they can retrieve their items from the clothing storage area in the post-race service area by showing their large race number.

(H) Athletes must carry valid identification (original ID card, household registration book, or passport) for verification.

(I) The following individuals are ineligible to participate in the competition:

1. Patients with congenital heart disease and rheumatic heart disease;
2. Patients with hypertension or cerebrovascular diseases;
3. Patients with myocarditis or other heart diseases;
4. Patients with coronary artery disease or severe arrhythmias;
5. Diabetic patients with extreme hyperglycemia or hypoglycemia;
6. Individuals with other diseases that are unsuitable for sports.

Marathon Competition Schedule:

Start Gun: 06:45 am

Closing Time:

42km: 120 minutes after the start gun.

21km: 60 minutes after the start gun.

The competition will use electronic timing, and all participating athletes must wear timing chips.

VII. Admission and Awards

(A) The top 8 in each category of the full marathon and half marathon will be awarded medals and certificates for 1st to 3rd places, and certificates for 4th to 8th places.

(B) There will be additional cash prizes for the top 6 in each category of the full marathon and half marathon.

(C) In categories with fewer than 6 participants, the number of admissions will be reduced by 1.

(D) Categories with fewer than 3 participants will be canceled.

(E) All athletes who complete the race in any category can collect a finisher medal in the post-race service area by presenting their large race number.

(F) Athletes can download their electronic finisher certificates after the race (download link to be announced separately).
