## **ARTISTIC WORLD CUP 2026**

We are pleased to share some updates about the upcoming Artistic World Cup event in Garmisch Partenkirchen.

### **PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE**

The updated schedule of the event will be available on **Infinity** for all the registered athletes, coaches and delegates.

### **OPENING CEREMONY**

Given the high number of athletes and in order to ensure the proper conduct of the competitions, the opening ceremony will not take place.

### **REGISTRATIONS**

#### **TOTS, MINI AND ESPOIR**

##### **DISCIPLINES:**

Free Skating, Solo Dance.

Coaches who participate only in Tots, Mini and Espoir category and **not** in the other categories must always be registered through the LOC.

## **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

Due to the high number of entries in all categories, we had to make some schedule changes. The following decisions were made:

- 1) Tots and Espoir freeskating training will be moved to the 7th, starting at 6:30 p.m.
- 2) Tots, Minis, and Espoir training will be without music.
- 3) The Tots and Espoir freeskating competitions will be moved to the 8th.
- 4) The opening ceremony will not take place
- 5) Pairs and dance couple groups will have five in each group instead of four.
- 6) Solo dance training for ladies and men will be combined.
- 7) The Solo Dance Cadet and Youth training will be one day earlier than scheduled.
- 8) Cadet, Youth and Junior Pairs training will be one day earlier than scheduled.
- 9) The freeskating cadet, youth, and ladies junior and senior groups will have eight skaters each in training.

The draw meeting will take place at the rink at 5:30 p.m. on the 7th.

## **NON OFFICIAL TRAININGS**

To book non-official training please write to [booking@driv-rollkunstlauf.de](mailto:booking@driv-rollkunstlauf.de)

Non-official training will be offered exclusively in the training rink (Olympiahalle, the hall located directly next to the competition venue). Whether non-official training will also be available on the competition rink outside the official training times and competition schedule will only be decided after the first week of competition.

The cost for booking the entire training rink is €100 per hour. Alternatively, individual skaters may register for training at a rate of €20 per skater per hour. The allocation of time slots between full rink bookings and individual bookings will depend on demand and may be adjusted at a later stage.

The registration process will be handled via two separate forms. The following link (<https://forms.gle/HFbXNyxsRPuUrVYHA>) can be used to book the entire training hall, while a separate link (<https://forms.gle/bosTeESIXbuVQNz68>) is provided for individual skater bookings. All bookings must be submitted as requests via these forms. We will confirm each request as soon as possible by email. The confirmation will also include details of the applicable training fees. Only upon confirmation will the booking be considered final and binding.
