WORLD SKATEBOARDING TOUR PARK 2026

We are pleased to announce the first stop of the World Skateboarding Tour 2026 for Park coming back again in Ostia Rome, Italy.

This event will be a **World Cup** event, and the results will contribute ranking points toward the World Skateboarding Ranking.

Technical Meeting will be conducted prior to the start of the competition.

ACCOMMODATION AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

The Official Accommodation for all athletes and National Federations will be the Camping Village Roma Capitol. In the [Official Brochure](#) you can find all the details to book with a promotional code. The prices of the accommodation include local transportation services between the hotel and the venue.

We recommend checking <https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/>, where a questionnaire will lead you to understand your VISA requirement for traveling to Italy.

Should you require a VISA:

1. **Complete registration for the event** on the World Skate Infinity Platform.
2. **Fill out [Annex 1](#)** with all the necessary information and email it to internazionale@fisr.it and operations@worldskate.org.
3. **Receive a protocol number** from the Italian National Olympic Committee (CONI) so that your VISA application process can be expedited.
4. **Apply for a VISA** at your local embassy or consulate.

Should you not require a VISA, but in need of a **generic invitation letter**, please complete Annex 1 and send it to internazionale@fisr.it.

COUNTRY QUOTA

Athletes:

National Federations are allowed to register 3 athletes per gender.

Pre-seeded skaters and the Extra Quota skaters do not count against the Country Quota registration limit.

National Federations do not need to register pre-seeded and extra quota skaters, they must only confirm their participation (more information available in the following sections).

Moreover, each NF has the right to register its President and its Secretary General.

EXTRA QUOTA FOR OSTIA PARK 2026

The tables in the next pages show the top 30 athletes in the World Skateboarding Ranking (WSR) as of April 8, 2026. It lists the individuals whom the respective NF are eligible to register as Extra Quota athletes, up to the top six ranked competitors of the country.

The ones marked with a star[★] are those currently holding the right to become Pre-seeded, as long as the National Federation registers and confirms their participation before the deadline. The deadline for confirmation is **May 25th, 2026 (23:59 CET)**.

The ones marked with an asterisk[*] are those that are ranked 7th or lower within their own country, but still have the right to take an Extra Quota if there is any withdrawal from their respective country and gender.

If a Pre-seeded athlete withdraws before the registration deadline, the next highest-ranked skater in the WSR will be pre-seeded. In such a case, we will contact the relevant NF directly.

The Pre-seeded athletes will skip the Open Qualifier and will be pre-seeded directly into the next competition phase.

For the details of Pre-seeded athletes, please refer to the Competition Season Criteria 2025 released on April 3, 2025.

Please note that all participants, including pre-seeded competitors, are required to pay the entry fee.

EVENT CHECK-IN

All skaters must complete the event check-in no later than 2 days before the first day of the competition. This deadline also applies to skaters pre-seeded in the Quarterfinals.

- Women & Men : **June 8th, 2026 at 06:00 pm (CET)**

REGISTRATION

The registration process will be carried out through the World Skate Infinity platform and will be open during the following period:

April 21st, 2026 (00:00 CET) - May 25th, 2026 (23:59 CET).

World Skate Infinity is available both on [desktop](#) (browser) and App Version on [Play Store \(Android\)](#) and [App Store \(iOS\)](#).

All single users (Athletes, National Team Members) must individually sign up on the platform either through the app or desktop and create a personal profile (if not already done). The profile must include all required personal information and the upload of the following mandatory documents:

- Copy of a valid passport
- A recent headshot/profile picture (passport-style with white background)
- Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate

Once the profile has been successfully created, they become eligible to be registered for the event by their respective National Federation.

Each National Federation must also confirm the participation of its Pre-seeded and Extra Quota Athletes within the World Skate Infinity Platform (browser version only) by the registration deadline. Please do not register Pre-Seeded and Extra Quota Athletes (QF or OQ seeding) within your Country Quota on your own, wait for them to be added and confirm (or not) their participation.

Entry Fee:

ALL participating athletes for the event will pay the following fee: **200 USD**.

Registration fees must be paid through Infinity, and can be completed via credit/debit card or bank transfer.

Please note: if paying by bank transfer, you must upload the proof of payment in Infinity. Without this proof, the payment cannot be confirmed. All bank transfer fees or charges incurred in connection with this transfer shall be borne by the sender.

Entry Fee payment deadline: **May 28th, 2026 (23:59 CET)**.

Note: The athletes that have not completed the payment will not be considered "Registered", and therefore they will not be listed in practice groups nor the competition heats.

Application for Neutral Athletes:

Russian and Belarusian athletes and their support personnel (when applicable) can participate only with a "Neutral status" following the ["Eligibility Criteria for the participation of Russian and Belarusian Athletes"](#).

Application for Neutral Athletes deadline: **May 11th, 2026 (23:59 CET)**.

Wild Card Requests:

Athletes otherwise not eligible to compete may be granted a Wild Card by World Skate.

Please note that a Wild Card is granted at World Skate's discretion and is limited to the cases provided for in the ["World Skate By-Laws"](#).

A Wild Card may be granted in case of lack of an existing and recognized NGB in the country of the athlete's origin.

In the case of a Country with a recognized NGB that does not include the sport concerned in its activities, the athletes shall mandatorily contact the relevant NGB for approval and clearance to compete for their respective Countries and under their own Anthem and Flag. Should the mentioned Governing Body not answer within 15 days, World Skate might allow the athlete concerned to compete under his/her Country Anthem and Flag.

Wild Card requests must be sent by e-mail to platform@worldskate.org within **May 18th, 2026 (23:59 CET)**.

MINOR'S PARENTS / LEGAL GUARDIANS

Minor's (U18) parents or legal guardians will be able to register to the event by clicking [here](#).

Only **one legal guardian or parent** per minor athlete can be registered, and expected to be present with their relevant athlete each day at their required registration time to sign documents.

Registration deadline is **May 25th, 2026 (23:59 CET)**.

Parents and legal guardians are also required to sign up and create a profile on [Infinity](#) as explained in the previous section. For the Category, they must select "Other".

Please note that providing your data and Passport in Infinity as a verification process for a minor athlete's profile, does not guarantee/provide a credential for the event.

ANTI-DOPING

The doping controls, the sample collection processes and the laboratory analysis will be conducted in accordance with the World Skate Anti-doping Rules, the International Standards for Testing and Investigation (ISTI), the WADA Code and following the instruction of the WSK AD Manager.

During the sign-up procedure to the Sports Registration System (World Skate Infinity, please see above), all athletes and staff members must upload a valid Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate. Those issued by WADA (through the Adel platform), ITA (International Testing Agency), National Anti-Doping Organizations and/or World Skate during 2024, 2025, and 2026 are accepted.

Should you need a new Anti-Doping Training Course Certificate, please visit the [WADA ADEL platform](#) and complete the relevant Course, according to your role.

We remind you that the [WADA ADEL platform](#) is not run by World Skate; therefore, should you have any issue in this regard, you will need to contact WADA's support directly.


